NORMANDY HERO accelerated to the early lead, saved ground on the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and prevailed under steady handling. RADICAL RIGHT stayed along the inner rail on the turn, swung outside the winner in mid stretch and rallied. YAHOO OMAR chased from the two path between horses around the turn, swung outside in upper stretch and weakened. TAKE A HINT , reluctant to load into the starting gate, steadied in close quarters about a sixteenth of a mile after the break, raced wide on the turn, drifted in near the sixteenth pole and weakened. DISCREET DEVIL was no factor. CONGRATS ON FIFTY bore out at the break, rushed up outside horses leaving the backstretch, stayed wide on the turn ,gave way and was eased.
