ENFORCER raced in close early, was taken back into the turn, awaited room, angled out, bid between horses, closed willingly and inched clear late. FEDERAL EXCHANGE vied inside, swung wide leaving the turn, inched clear, drifted out late and was outclosed to finish second best. MOGALU pressed four to five wide, dropped back on the turn, put in a steady bid and earned show. MEGAN'S HONOR settled off the pace, angled out on the turn, went wide in the drive and closed well. TWENTY ONE KID was hustled along, vied between horses, swung out leaving the turn, dropped back, weakened in the drive and faded from contention. DITHER vied between horses to the turn, weakened in the drive and faded. WINOOSKI trailed the field.
