GENGHIS was unhurried early, came three-wide into the stretch and closed strongly. RUNYONESQUE raced in the back of the field early, came four-wide into the stretch and rallied late. INTREPID'S LEGACY was close-up early racing along the inside, dropped back on the turn while in tight, came two-wide into the stretch and was unable to seriously threaten. NEON SIGN saved ground setting the pace to near the stretch and tired
