CARENTAN set a pressured pace, dueled in tight quarters through the stretch and prevailed in a long drive. SLOBBERKNOCKER bumped at the start, was in tight entering the first turn, raced close to the pace towards the outside, challenged three across on the turn, dueled in tight quarters through the stretch and was outmodded to just miss. CHANCE broke out, was slow early, rallied into the turn, swung wide entering the stretch, closed steadily and didn't have enough late. CATATUMBO brushed at the start, trailed the field, bid inside leaving the turn and closed well. LIMO bumped at the start, was in tight entering the first turn, pressed the pace, stopped into the second turn and dropped back. MORIKAWA brushed at the start, vied for the lead, stopped into the second turn and was not urged late. BETTER THEN LOTTO was in tight into the first turn, saved ground, was through early and eased.
