MOGALU settled off the pace, advanced through the far turn to make an outside bid in the stretch, surged past foes late to secure the victory. FIGHT FIERCELY pressed the pace from the inside, dueled foe in the stretch, began to pull away in the final sixteenth but got nailed by outside driving foe. NORFIE raced in the middle of the pack, made a four wide bid at the top of the stretch to duel rival, weakened in the final sixteenth. BOOK MARKER raced off the pace, angled out four wide in the stretch to rally but flattened out late. BELTS 'N BROOKS settled back to trail early, passed tired foes in the stretch. BOLD AMBITION pressed the pace three wide early, faded in the final furlong. RAISEDAROOFCHARLIE took the early lead in the two path to set a pressured pace, gave way at the top of the stretch, angled along the rail and retreated.
