DIP FANTASIA vied throughout and proved best in a long drive. MISS MO TOWN vied throughout and was outfinished in a game effort. CITIFIED broke slowly, advanced inside to the turn, angled out and closed well to earn show. RUN CHACHY RUN brushed at the start, found her best stride late and just missed for third. LITTLE GUSSIE raced close to the pace, dropped back on the turn, swung wide entering the stretch and lacked the needed late rally. COLONIAL DANCER raced in close, swung wide into the stretch and lacked a late response. SEVEN'S MAGIC put in a steady effort in a wide trip and failed to menace. MOMENTOUS AFFAIR bumped at the start, swung wide leaving the turn and lacked a bid. RECKLESS ABANDON stumbled at the start to be off slowly, trailed the field and improved position in a steady effort. PANCHITA vied to the turn and stopped. LET 'ER SIZZLE brushed at the start, bid along the rail on the turn and lacked a stretch response. ZIPPY DO DA DAY bumped at the start and was outrun. IZZY'S ROCK STAR was not a factor.
