NAZEER pressed the pace two wide, assumed command into the stretch, drew off for a clear lead, widened and finished much the best. COACH CRISTOBAL set a pressured pace to the turn, was no match for the winner and all out for place. SOMERTON CASTLE broke slowly and was crowded at the start, was slow early, rallied on the turn, closed well and just missed for second. JEZEEN raced close to the pace along the inside, lacked a stretch response and hung in the lane. ROCKYROAD raced mid pack, swung wide entering the stretch and lacked a bid. EL WOODSIE saved ground while racing mid pack, dropped back into the turn and gave way. SCORCHY TORCHY raced outside, showed speed to the turn and gave way. DIAMOND BOY BLUE put in an even effort in an outside trip and failed to threaten. RUNNICKYRUN dwelt at the start and showed little.
