GROUP TICKET tracked the leaders from five wide down the backside, rallied on the turn in an early drive to steadily advance to the lead and pulled clear in the final furlong. CATATUMBO unhurried to be near the rear of the field to the far turn, made a steady rally following the winner around the bend and finished willingly to be up for the place. SANTOS TO WILSON hustled from the gate to take a clear lead into the first turn racing four wide, continued on to be clear to the far turn, responded gamely when challenged to give way stubbornly in the lane. REMEMBERING WILBUR stalked the pace from between rivals, lacked a closing bid and kept-on in the stretch for a minor award. LOOKIN AT ROSES reserved off the pace racing between rivals near the rear of the field to the final turn and circled wide turning for home with some late interest. STYLE ME ROYAL went evenly failing to menace. LONG ASTRIDE slow early to trail and never posed a threat. CAUGHTANDCOLLECTED was well placed saving ground along the fence in contention to the final bend and faded lacking a response when called upon. KING OF HOLLYWOOD prompted the pace early and gave way.
