KATARZYNA assumed command on the backstretch, drew clear entering the turn and held well. AIBELL lagged early, went wide in the drive, closed with a

rush, was gaining fast late and got up late for place. HOTTER THAN FIRE raced close to the pace, closed steadily, gained late and was caught for second. HALE BOP led around the first turn, pressed inside, dropped back into the turn, continued in a steady bid, didn't have enough late and lost position in a good effort. WILL OF VICTORY raced close to the pace, shifted out for the drive and went willingly to the wire. COCOA MILLS raced mid pack, put in a steady effort and narrowed the gap. CALL ME TONI failed to threaten in an even effort. SAUCY SIX was slow early, bid inside on the turn and failed to rally. RUBY HAMILTON led briefly, raced close to the pace along the inside, bid along the rail on the turn, had nothing left and was not urged late. POWER AND GLORY trailed the field and passed tiring rivals. MEZZO SOPRANO was not a factor. SMOKESHOW raced mid pack in an even effort and was outrun.
