BUGGED OUT rushed for a short lived lead at the start before settling behind the pace in the two path, rallied in the final furlong to be able to put a head in front right at the wire. ADA MAY rushed to the lead shortly after the start, began to pull away by a couple lengths in the stretch before being contested in the final furlong and getting nailed at the wire. GREGORIAN SOLO settled off the pace, saved ground in the turn to take the inside of the stretch, made a three wide bid in the final furlong to show a mild rally but was unable to catch the leaders. WARRIORS JEWEL settled behind the pace between rivals, showed signs of weakening early in the stretch before rallying in the final furlong to improve position. HARMONIZING rated five wide off the pace, improved position in the stretch. HEAVENS EXPRESS unhurried at the start to be the early trailer, split foes to save ground in the turn, flattened out in the stretch. BOUNTY KILLAH rated between rivals in the middle of the pack, made a four wide bid at the top of the stretch but could not sustain bid and faded. LADY LANCER rated four wide behind the pace, retreated in the final quarter. MISS NEO raced in the middle of the pack on the inside, retreated at the three eighths, eased across.
