RAY'S BLUE WAGON pressed the early pace from the two path, took command at the halfway point, firmly held lead through the stretch. WORK HARD raced three wide in the middle of the pack, loomed through the far turn four wide to enter the stretch in a competitive position behind the pace, had no closing bid. BULLRING BULLY slow start to be the last out of the gate, advanced along the inside to be off the pace, angled out six wide in the far turn to gain position and show a mild rally in the stretch. ELECTIONEERING slow start, trailed for most, rallied along the far outside of the stretch. JOSH settled off the pace, split foes in the stretch to improve position. WINE EMPIRE raced not too far behind the pace three wide, made an inside bid in the stretch but came up empty. WAR COMMANDER raced in the middle of the pack along the outside, made no improvements. DUKE OF DOOLY raced in the middle of the pack four wide, angled towards the inside at the final furlong, unable to rally. SIDNEY'S BID raced behind the pace in the two path, retreated in the stretch. SIR CHANCE A LOT quickly claimed the early lead, relinquished the lead at the half, faded to trail entering the stretch, eased across.
