Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 at over a mile on the turf in 2025, 3 lbs.; Non-winners of \$30,000 on the turf since July 27th, 2025, 5 lbs. (Maiden, claiming and starter races not considered in estimating allowances). Closed Wednesday, September 17, 2025 with 34 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management not to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Eighth).

MISCHIEF IN MOTION broke well, got to the inside and to the front, was left to dictate a moderate pace while rating kindly under a hold, kicked away on cue at the top of the stretch and went unchallenged to the finish. DON'T JINX IT settled close up to the inside, was unable to keep up when MISCHIEF IN MOTION went clear at the top of the stretch but chased with interest to gain and hold the place. AMBAYA tracked three-wide through the early stages, never too far from the front, kept to a three-wide path through the far turn then finished up well but was no threat to the winner. SIGH NO MORE (IRE) was unhurried from the start, launched a bid just before the three-furlong pole, came four wide into the stretch, improved position but could not get to the top three. CONCH FRIED RICE settled near the rear of the field, saved ground, then kept on late to improve. DOUBLE VELOCITY raced in the middle of the pack, saved ground but lacked the needed rally. PRETTY LAVISH (IRE) stalked the early pace two-wide then gave way near the quarter pole. DELAYED raced near the rear of the pack through the early stages, then was outfinished in the late stages.
