Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

KALADIN laid up close inside, was ridden into the far turn, tipped out to the four path entering the lane, stayed on to bid inside the final sixteenth, and got up at the wire. LATIN REBEL showed the way, was cued along the rail passing the quarter, drew clear from the two path in upper stretch, but got nailed by an outer foe at the wire. MAX SWAGGER chased inside, was ridden around the far turn, angled out to the five path in upper stretch, and ran on for show. BOLD LICORICE rated in the two path, was roused along the inside passing the three-eighths, and kept on in the three path down the lane. MODICA was unhurried in the three path early, waited along the rail around the far turn, was roused into the stretch, and improved. SHELLBACK bumped with an inner foe at the start, raced in midpack in the three path but was one paced. K'S STORM READY trailed in the four path, fanned out to the seven path turning into the lane, and passed tired inner rivals. MERGING TRAFFIC was wellback in the four path early and made no impact. HEAVEN'S CHAMPION bumped between foes at the start, tracked in the three path, swung from the five path into the lane, but weakened. HASTEN stalked in the four path but weakened in the final furlong. REGGAE MAN broke out and bumped an outer foe, chased in the five path but did not threaten. MAJOR OFFENSIVE pressed in the three path but gave way in the stretch.
