VICTORIOUS DREAM (IRE) stalked in the two path into the first turn then moved inside, drafted behind the leader around the far turn, tipped out and challenged RED CHERRY at the top of the lane, seized control midstretch and drove clear. RED CHERRY stepped to the front and controlled the pace from inside, met the bid from PEPPERMINT DASH on the far turn, put that rival away entering the stretch, challenged by VICTORIOUS DREAM (IRE) at the top of the lane, relinquished the lead past the eighth pole and stayed on to secure second. SOUL SISTER settled along the rail, look to advance but lacked room when boxed in next to the fence on the far turn, angled out leaving that bend, showed late run and got up for third. PEPPERMINT DASH was closest in pursuit from the two path in the opening stages, challenged from outside on far turn, got turned away approaching the stretch and churned on for a minor award. WAITING FOR YOU (GB) trailed outside a rival early on, remained two wide into the far turn, got floated out nearing the lane and failed to menace. STRUCK BY HER (IRE) followed in range three wide then moved into the two path around the first turn, coaxed along in those paths around the second bend, angled four wide at the top of the lane and flattened out.
