SPECIAL CLUB tracked the speed from off the rail, launched a bid three deep on the turn, put ahead in front in upper stretch, dueled outside OTTO THE CONQUEROR through the lane and gamely prevailed. OTTO THE CONQUEROR stalked COMEDY TOWN in the early going, bid between runners at the quarter pole while having the rider lose the crop, grabbed a brief lead entering the lane but quickly overtaken by SPECIAL CLUB, battled back inside that rival, had the rider lose his right iron at the sixteenth pole, dug in valiantly but came up just short in the end. ZEUS' WAR broke out, settled off the pace, gained four deep through the turn, could not keep touch with the top pair in upper stretch but finished determinedly for a clear third. HEY BROTHER raced near the back then trailed early, went two wide into the turn, quickly moved to the three path and passed tired rivals in the lane. GYPSY TEARS got shuffled back early, moved forward, chased two wide around the turn and weakened in the drive. COMEDY TOWN dueled briefly then took a clear lead, took pressure late on the turn, lost the lead turning for home and weakened. SOI NGERN dueled briefly then gave chase from inside, hugged the rail through the turn and faded in the stretch.

TASHIE pressed from inside, fought on even terms around the bend, inched ahead midstretch and drew away from PRINCESS LUNA in deep stretch. PRINCESS LUNA showed the way early outside TASHIE, dueled with that rival on the turn, battled into the final furlong, was no match for the winner in the last sixteenth and was able to hold on for second. HER STRUT got crowded between rivals early, moved inside racing off the pace, saved ground around the bend, ran into traffic turning for home, angled out into the clear and showed late run to almost get up for second. I'M SMOKEN HOT tracked from inside, coaxed along through the turn then asked for more at the quarter pole, finished evenly down the lane and earned a minor award. TAKE REVENGE settled off the pace, exited the backstretch in the three path, chased four deep into the stretch and lacked a rally. ENDLESS SMOKE tracked three deep, remained three wide to the stretch, bothered by inner rival at the eighth pole and could not rally. THIRSTY CAITLIN pursued the top pair from between rivals, traveled in the two path on the turn, angled in upper stretch and weakened. MS GRAINGER DANGER chased four deep early on, remained wide through the turn and had little left for the stretch run. VERONICA HERZ got crowded between rivals early, trailed up the backstretch, went three wide into the turn, came five wide into the stretch and was never a factor.

LONG MAYSHE REIGN vied inside a trio of rivals up the backstretch, inched ahead of outer pair on the turn, showed the way into the final furlong and held off the late run from PURE CHAOS in the final strides. PURE CHAOS traveled in mid-pack on the inside, shifted to the two path on the turn, steered out to unleash a rally in the lane, surged late and ran out of ground. PAVEL IS APPEALING sat off the pace on the inside, ridden along around the bend, moved out in upper stretch, put in a late bid and edged TIGER OF THE SEA for the show honors. TIGER OF THE SEA vied four deep early, brushed with inner rival entering the turn, fought three deep around the bend, finished willingly down the lane but lacked the needed late punch. FANCY FACTS vied between rivals up the backstretch and around the turn, lost touch with the leader with a furlong remaining and stayed on to the wire. A GREAT SHAKING was off slow to begin, followed in range outside a pair of rivals, altered in a bit on the turn, chased two wide into the lane, came out in upper stretch and offered a mild rally. ELLEN JORTH tracked between from between runners, paused early on the turn and moved inside, hugged the rail to the stretch and needed to

find more in the furlong grounds. BERRY VALLEY coaxed along early from off the pace, navigated the turn two then three wide and failed to rally. WINK AND A GRIN allowed to trail the field in the early going, traveled in the two path on the turn, swung out leaving the bend and could not make an impact. CELESTIAL SKIES raced three deep from off the pace, altered six wide around STARS HOLLOW on the turn, came back to the four path, drifted into the stretch and failed to threaten. STARS HOLLOW vied three deep between rivals, got put in tight and checked at the three-eighths pole, dropped back on the turn, eased in the lane and walked off.

GROUND SUPPORT angled to the inside stalking the speed, followed behind the leader through the far turn, lacked room from upper to midstretch and kept trying once moving to a clear path. CORTINA D'AMPREZZO (IRE) dueled outside LIGHT WON UP to the top of the

lane, fought between rivals midstretch and weakened in the last sixteenth. SPIRIT DOLL stalked in the two path between runners, remained two wide into the far turn, bid four wide at the quarter pole and flattened out in the final furlong. LIGHT WON UP dueled for command from inside, carried a short lead through the far turn, resisted into the final furlong, relinquished the lead midstretch and weakened. WILD LIKE THE WEST traveled in mid-pack on the inside, launched a bid in the two patch then challenged three deep on the far turn, fought between in the lane, lost his path and checked at the sixteenth pole and lost all momentum. MARJORAM stalked three deep in the early going, coaxed along four deep on the far turn, trailed into the stretch and tired. THERE WAS AN INQUIRY INVOLVING INBOX (GB) AND WILD LIKE THE WEST NEAR THE SIXTEENTH POLE. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS RULED THAT ALTHOUGH INBOX (GB) DID CROSS OVER AND CAUSE WILD LIKE THE WEST TO TAKE UP, THE INCIDENT DID NOT WARRANT A DISQUALIFICATION.

NATIVE LAND stalked four then three wide around the first turn, moved up to challenge the leader from outside in the middle stages, took over past the five-sixteenths pole, put away inner rival in upper stretch, challenged by PURE MADNESS late and was able to hold. PURE MADNESS stalked in the two path, loomed three wide at the quarter pole, chased determinedly into the final furlong, dug in the last sixteenth and was gaining alongside the winner but could not get by. MAGNIFY raced outside a rival at the back of the pack, ridden along thee deep in the middle stages, chased between foes into the far turn, angled out and entered the lane in the five path, showed a mild rally and gained the show honors. CENTRAL DISPATCH sprinted to the front and moved to the two path, headed by NATIVE LAND on the backstretch, lost the lead midway around the far turn, yielded to the winner in upper stretch and flattened to fourth. KOEKKOEK (GB) traveled in mid-pack from the rail, crept closer leaving the backstretch, angled out at the top of the lane, challenged with a furlong remaining, grabbed the lead with a sixteenth remaining and drove clear. CONQUER WE MUST (IRE) was off slow to begin, reserved in the early going and taken to the inside, patiently handled around the far turn, give his cue at the top of the lane, angled out into the clear, showed late run and got up to earn second. YEP (GB) tracked from inside, moved into range on the backstretch, tipped out at the top of the lane, put in a bid with a furlong remaining, led

briefly midstretch but got outkicked by the top pair in the final sixteenth. PLAGARIST dueled from outside into the first turn, raced close up outside the leader on the backstretch, applied pressure once again on the far turn, took over at the top of the lane, relinquished the lead midstretch and flattened to fourth. GO RALPH sat off the pace in the two path, steered out into the lane, came with a mild rally and improved position. MIGHTY TORO dueled from inside into the first turn, seized control on the backstretch, challenged by PLAGARIST again on the far turn, lost command at the top of the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. PEACE ON EARTH laid off the pace from the rail then moved into the two path, continued two wide around the far turn, steered out at the top of the stretch and lacked further response. FLAMBOYANT was off slow to begin, guided to the rail racing near the back, angled from the two path to the four path around the far turn, steered out further in the lane and failed to threaten. CORKSCREW ANDY settled in the two path, moved into striking distance in the middle stages, came under a ride on the far turn, got floated out a bit in the lane and weakened. MOLUCCAN was off slow leaving the gate, traveled on the inside at the back, had one rival beat turning for home and could not make an impact. AMERICAN KING moved around just before the gates opened and came away slow, trailed outside MOLUCCAN, had sole ownership of the last on the far turn and never got involved.
