HOWIE'S LAW sprinted clear to set the tone, drew away on the turn, padded the lead in upper stretch and widened under right handed urging. PHAROAH'S CANDY stalked three deep early, chased three then two wide on the turn, could not make any headway on the winner in the lane but was able to best the rest. JETWAY chased after the lone speed between rivals, rounded the bend in the two path then found the rail past the quarter pole, failed to produce a bid in the stretch run and was beaten for second. FREDDY FIVE FOUR stumbled leaving the gate, trailed from well off the rail early, navigated the turn four then three wide and never threatened. ELUSIVE CON raced off the pace, took the turn three then two wide, angled in from behind a rival in upper stretch and was never a factor. FINIBALL was off slow to begin, ridden along at the back on the inside, tipped three wide leaving the turn and was never a factor. HOOSICK FALLS chased the leader inside a pair of rivals, dropped back on the turn and tired.

PHONE BOOTH bobbled leaving the gate, vied three deep between foes to the turn, lost touch with the leader at the five-sixteenths pole, chased two wide into the stretch, dug in to collar SOUTHWEST SUN at the sixteenth pole and proved best in the end. SOUTHWEST SUN took a short lead between runners in the early going, moved clear at the five-sixteenths pole, showed the way into the final furlong, collared by PHONE BOOTH outside the sixteenth pole and could not hold on. LITTLE KING vied five then four deep in the opening stages, failed to keep pace and chased five wide into the turn, angled down to the three path, challenged again midstretch but lacked the needed final kick. SCAM ALERT vied between runners then got shuffled out of the mix at the half-mile pole, went four wide into the turn, angled to the two path, spun three wide into the lane and kept trying for a minor award. GOODTIMESNTANLINES coaxed from the gate, chased from inside out of range, angled out past the quarter pole and weakened. NO LIMIT was reluctant to load, fought for the lead inside rivals to the three-eighths pole, failed to keep up with the leader midway around the bend, saved ground to the stretch and tired. TUDDY got crowded and bobbled early, trailed five wide into the turn, angled to the three path, exited the bend four wide and was never a factor.

SUMTER sat off the pace in the opening stages, took the turn two wide, tipped out into the stretch, rallied four deep at the sixteenth pole and edged MOTORIOUS (GB) for the score. MOTORIOUS (GB) chased after the dueling leaders outside a rival, continued two wide through the turn, moved out in upper stretch, challenged three deep between foes at the sixteenth pole and got outclosed by the winner. SORRENTO SKY (IRE) trailed early, went outside a rival on the turn, angled out in the stretch, closed from outside and earned third. FLYOVER held a narrow advantage dueling inside BOOK SMART up the backstretch and around the turn, battled into the final furlong, clung to the lead inside a trio of rivals at the sixteenth pole and yielded shortly after. BOOK SMART fought for command outside FLYOVER, went head to head into the final furlong, vied between runners briefly at the sixteenth pole and weakened late. NESSO'S LASTHARRAH chased after the top pair from the rail to the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CALL ME CORY got crowded in the beginning, put in tight again early, steered to the inside racing at the back, hugged the rail to the stretch and could not make an impact.

CHARLIE FOXTROT followed closely in the early going, launched a bid three deep on the turn, dueled outside GOT'M COT'M into the stretch, fought head to head down the lane and bested the runner-up in the final fifty yards. GOT'M COT'M vied inside a pair of rivals then dueled into the turn, cleared at the five-sixteenths pole, challenged by CHARLIE FOXTROT late on the bend, battled through the lane and yielded grudgingly late. LETMEIN got bumped between rivals at the start, lagged behind early, trailed three wide into the turn, moved to the two path briefly then came three wide into the stretch, angled out and rallied to get up for third. HERE'S SOME MORE stalked from off the rail, went two wide into the turn, angled to the inside while picking up stride, steered out in upper stretch and flattened in the late stages. CRUISIN FOR CALI bumped with LETMEIN leaving the gate, settled off the inside then outside a rival, driven three wide into the lane and never responded. PALMER BEACH bobbled and bumped with LETMEIN at the start, coaxed along while climbing up the backstretch, raced on the inside into the turn, angled out and came three wide into the stretch, then failed to threaten down the lane. NEED MO DIAMONDS fought for the lead between rivals, got crowded a bit past the half-mile pole, dropped back on the turn, tired and eased in the lane and walked off. CHAPTER ONE vied three deep then dueled into the turn, yielded the leader at the five-sixteenths pole and started to weaken around the bend, tired and eased in the lane and walked off. JOHNLINO broke out, stalked widest of all in the opening stages, went four wide into the turn, drifted into the stretch, eased in the lane and walked off.

AH JEEZ unhurried in the early going and settled in the two path, moved forward four deep, closed in four then three wide on the far turn, challenged three deep turning for home, quickly seized control drove clear from CALM SEA and held safely late. ENTERDADRAGON raced well off the pace a bit off the rail around the first turn, exited the backstretch three deep, went three then four wide around that bend, angled out in the lane, showed late run to earn second but could not threaten the winner. ZALAMO (FR) traveled outside a rival towards the rear, found the rail on the far turn, steered out at the top of the lane, finished well between rivals and gained third. CALM SEA prominent early outside the leader then took a stalking position on the inside, was closest in pursuit of the pacesetter up the backstretch, drew closer while losing second on the far turn, put in a rail bid entering the lane, was no match for the winner in the final furlong and flattened to fourth. GEOMETRY laid off the pace outside a rival, went three deep into the far turn, picked up stride around the bend, chased two wide approaching the stretch, angled out for the stretch run and also flattened out. GOLD FOOT reserved in the opening stages and steered to the inside, hugged the rail to the stretch and could not threaten. JIMMY BLUE JEANS chased from inside out of range, fell back to the middle of the field, closed in around the far turn and weakened in the drive. DON'T SWEAR DAVE stalked out of range in the two path, dropped off the pace, checked midway around the far turn and lacked a rally. EMPIRE'S CLASSIC trailed on the inside to the far turn, angled out at the quarter pole, came four wide into the stretch and was never a factor. CHARGE FOR GOLD sped clear and opened up a big lead, drifted out on the backstretch, carried a diminishing lead to the quarter pole. ONE OF THESE DAYS (IRE) laid well off the pace on the inside, eased out to the three path on the far turn and never got involved. PHOSPHORESCENCE (FR) settled in the two path, came under a ride on the far turn, moved out at the top of the lane, eased in the final furlong and walked off.
