PHONE BOOTH bobbled leaving the gate, vied three deep between foes to the turn, lost touch with the leader at the five-sixteenths pole, chased two wide into the stretch, dug in to collar SOUTHWEST SUN at the sixteenth pole and proved best in the end. SOUTHWEST SUN took a short lead between runners in the early going, moved clear at the five-sixteenths pole, showed the way into the final furlong, collared by PHONE BOOTH outside the sixteenth pole and could not hold on. LITTLE KING vied five then four deep in the opening stages, failed to keep pace and chased five wide into the turn, angled down to the three path, challenged again midstretch but lacked the needed final kick. SCAM ALERT vied between runners then got shuffled out of the mix at the half-mile pole, went four wide into the turn, angled to the two path, spun three wide into the lane and kept trying for a minor award. GOODTIMESNTANLINES coaxed from the gate, chased from inside out of range, angled out past the quarter pole and weakened. NO LIMIT was reluctant to load, fought for the lead inside rivals to the three-eighths pole, failed to keep up with the leader midway around the bend, saved ground to the stretch and tired. TUDDY got crowded and bobbled early, trailed five wide into the turn, angled to the three path, exited the bend four wide and was never a factor.
