MO BAD chased after the top pair outside a rival, moved into the three path at the quarter pole, took aim four wide turning for home, surged to the front in upper stretch, fought with BO DIDDLEY while drifting in the final furlong and maintained a short lead over that rival to the wire. BO DIDDLEY broke inward, chased from inside, bid along the fence in upper stretch, fought with MO BAD the last eighth of a mile and could not get by. SMOKEM WICKED followed in range, chased a bit off the rail or in the two path on the turn, angled out from behind the leaders near the eighth pole and finished willingly to earn third. HERE COMES TOO TOO pressed the pace from outside, headed the leader midway around the bend, grabbed a narrow advantage with quarter mile remaining, relinquished the lead to MO BAD in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. WINSOR GEORGE showed the way under pressure from HERE COMES TOO TOO early, headed by that rival at the five-sixteenths pole, lost command late on the bend, fought between into the final furlong, then flattened out in the late stages. CLUB FIGHTER coaxed along near the back early, took the turn two wide and failed to menace. CITY OF FORZA broke in, tracked from just out of range along the inside, dropped back while easing further off the rail on the turn, went three wide into the lane and weakened. SIP SIP CHARLY broke in, dropped back under urging, trailed on the inside and was never a factor.

LITTLE OPAL sprinted clear, showed the way on the inside through the turn, coaxed along into the stretch, continued clear with a furlong remaining, asked right handed at the sixteenth pole and responded nicely by drawing off late. FIRST OR LAST was closest in pursuit from the two path, loomed to the outside of the leader turning for home, watched the winner kick away in the furlong grounds and stayed on to prove second best. BRAZORIA (GB) lacked early speed, took the turn two wide, split foes at the sixteenth pole and gained third. HIGH SOCIETY U chased after the pacesetter in the two path, moved out at the top of the lane and could not produce a bid. GREY MATTER took a stalking position on the inside, remained on the fence to the stretch and weakened. DECISIVE DECEPTION traveled outside a rival near the back in the early going, went three wide around the bend and failed to respond when called upon. TIZ ALLURING chased from off the pace then pulled while moving to the inside and had to take hold off heels leaving the backstretch, saved ground through the turn and failed to rally. CHERRY CANDY was off slow from the inside, raced along the fence at the back and never made an impact.

FIRE BAN bobbled leaving the gate, raced up close five deep around the first turn, vied four then three deep on the backstretch, took over three wide past the three-eighths pole, put inner pair away with a quarter mile remaining, challenged by ANGEL BABY entering the stretch, lost command at the eighth pole, fought back from inside and edged away from the runner-up in deep stretch. ANGEL BABY tracked in the two path, between rivals at the halfway marker, asked while angling out on the far turn, bid four wide turning for home, put a head in front with a furlong left to run, battled with FIRE BAN into the last sixteenth and faltered late. CHANNEL PLACE took a short lead inside outer quartet early, fought on even terms at the half-mile pole, lost command past the three-eighths pole, failed to keep up with the new leader at the quarter pole, kept trying through the lane and held third. ALLIHIES chased along the inside, dropped off the pace outside a rival in the middle stages, rounded the far turn two to three wide and kept on through the lane to earn a minor award. PHOTOGENIC pressed three deep around the first turn, moved up on even terms on the backstretch, fought between rivals to the five-sixteenths pole, yielded to the winner late on the bend and faded in the drive. INTERPLAY trailed in the two path to the far turn, angled five wide around the bend and passed tired rivals in the stretch. TULAVIA'S WORLD forwardly placed four deep between runners early, failed to keep up with the leading ground past the midway point, chased three to four wide on the far turn and tired. MUSICAL SONG vied between into the first turn, took a stalking position and angled in on the backstretch, came off the rail while dropping back on the far turn and tired. CRAZY CAMI stumbled leaving the gate, traveled on the inside then in the two path early, ridden along inside a rival on the backstretch, tipped off the fence on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and also tired.

STAMP MY PASSPORT was closest in pursuit in the opening rounds while moving to the inside, came under a ride on the far turn, tipped out at the top of the stretch, chased determinedly through the lane, lacked the needed late kick and was able to secure second. DUKE OF ORLEANS also bumped and got crowded in the beginning, raced off the rail then between rivals off the pace, traveled two wide on the turn, steered out in the lane and closed well to earn second. HE'S GOT FIRE broke in and bumped, pressed the pace from outside, headed the leader at the quarter pole, carried a short lead into the stretch, clung to a narrow advantage at the sixteenth pole and yielded late. SHE'S NO QUANT got bumped between rivals at the start, stalked the speed from between runners, brushed with DONTTELLMEWHATTODO at the half-mile pole, got crowded and lost a bit of ground into the turn, came under a ride past the five-sixteenths pole, was closest in pursuit turning for home, loomed boldly in upper stretch, drew alongside MOHAVEN shortly after, seized control outside the sixteenth pole and maintained command over MOHAVEN to the wire. MOHAVEN dueled briefly from outside then cleared to take control in the early going, showed the way along the inside through the turn, given her cue at the top of the stretch, collared by SHE'S NO QUANT midstretch, relinquished the lead into the final sixteenth and stayed on well for a clear second. TAPATIA MIA was antsy in the gate, lacked early speed, traveled two to three wide on the turn, angled five wide leaving the bend, produced a mild rally and bested the others. TAKING A JOY RIDE bumped with inner rival at the nine-sixteenths pole, chased three deep into the turn, remained off the rail to the stretch and could not summon the needed rally. LINO'S ANGEL tracked on the inside out of range, moved into the two path then came back to the rail around the bend, cut the corner into the stretch and lacked further response. LYNDÉE'S DREAM broke in and bumped, got crowded in the early going, got crowded again up the backstretch then bumped with TAKING A JOY RIDE at the nine-sixteenths pole, ridden along two, three, then four wide on the turn and failed to menace. LIBERATION stalked three deep early, cut to the two path entering the turn to bother the winner, found the rail past the five-sixteenths pole and faded down the lane. TROISIEME ETOILE brushed leaving the gate, traveled near the back off the rail then three deep into the

turn, moved to the four path around the bend and came up empty in the stretch run. DONTTELLMEWHATTODO was antsy in the gate, dueled briefly for the lead then chased after the pacesetter inside a pair of rivals, brushed with the winner at the half-mile pole, got put in tight approaching the five-sixteenths marker, dropped back around the turn and tired.

FEELING LUCKY showed the way in the two path around the first turn, moved inside on the backstretch and took pressure from ROYAL RUMOR, dueled around the far turn, resisted into the last sixteenth and disposed of ROYAL RUMOR late. ROYAL RUMOR stalked in the three then two path, applied pressure to FEELING LUCKY on the backstretch, fought on even terms around the far turn, battled into the final furlong, faltered in deep stretch but was able to save second. FLASH OF LIGHTNING trailed two wide around the first turn, traveled three deep on the backstretch, navigated the far turn three then four wide, closed well through the lane and missed second. HIGH KING angled to the rail stalking into the first turn, went between rivals around the bend,

came under ride leaving the backstretch and found the rail, moved back into range on the far turn, steered out in the lane and finished willingly to round out the superfecta. DOING TIME settled in the two path, between rivals at the back in the middle stages, got put in tight past the three-eighths pole, angled four wide, steered out widest in the lane and showed a mild rally to improve position. BENNY'S PUZZLE steered to the inside racing at the back early, had to take up at the three-eighths pole, moved to the two path at the quarter pole, tipped three wide entering the lane, angled out further in upper stretch and kept on between runners in the final furlong. GOING NOWHERE away quickest and was prominent early while guided to the rail, stalked the top pair up the backstretch, shifted three wide at the quarter pole and weakened down the lane. HE'S PROOF OF JOY laid off the pace on the inside, got shuffled back into the far turn, continued on the inside to the stretch and was never a factor. MONSIEUR BIG settled outside a rival then got moved to the four path around the clubhouse turn, dropped off the pace, ridden along in the two path on the far turn and faded in the lane. BIG VENGEANCE tracked along the rail into the first turn then angled to the three path, asked two then three wide on the second bend and tired.
