KINZLEE'SCHARISMA stalked the top trio from well off the rail, picked up stride in the four path on the turn, challenged three deep turning for home, seized control in upper stretch and proved best under a drive to the wire. SMOKIN HOT STUFF prompted the pace from outside, vied between runners entering the lane, could not match strides with the winner into the final furlong, remained close through the final furlong and finished a game second. SWIMMINGLY raced up close outside the top pair, chased in the three path for most of the turn before tipping four wide nearing the stretch, kept trying in the late stages and was able to regain the show honors. MY GIRL MIA set the pace under threat from SMOKIN HOT STUFF, maintained a short lead through the turn, offered little resistance to the winner in upper stretch and flattened to fourth in the last sixteenth. CAMMY'S GIRL got crowded leaving the gate, trailed on the inside then moved into the two path, tipped three wide on the turn to pass rivals but could not find more to be a threat in the stretch run. JOY THE IMAGE coaxed along the inside from off the pace, dropped back on the turn and failed to menace. MASHIE NIBLICK raced off the pace between runners, dropped back in the two path on the turn and had little left for the drive. KYATHOS traveled outside a pair of rivals from off the pace, lost ground three then two wide on the turn and tired.

BAKO COUNTRY dropped back early while racing greenly, trailed into the turn, passed rivals while saving ground through the turn, steered out in upper stretch, rallied four deep into the last sixteenth and drove clear late. MY BOX OF LIGHT angled to the inside settling off the pace, advanced from the fence

through the turn, closed in under left handed urging in upper stretch, challenged from between runners midstretch and got outclosed by the winner. CIMARRON STRIP showed the way under pressure early, cleared leaving the backstretch, asked right hand at the top of the stretch, led into the final furlong, challenged by rivals midstretch and yielded late. TREXIMO pressed the leader from outside then lost contact with that rival into the turn, chased two wide to the stretch, re-bid three deep in the furlong grounds but flattened late. BUCKS ACTION traveled outside a pair of rivals from off the pace, angled out around the turn, came six wide into the stretch, showed late effort but was not enough. BATTLE SCHOOL was in pursuit from the inside, moved off the rail on the turn, raced in a bit tight at the quarter pole, once again at the three-sixteenths pole, gained a clear path and kept trying but failed to threaten. SUN CHASER chased three wide into the turn, spun four wide into the stretch and weakened. TACOS AND TEQUILA climbed along early chasing in range then dropped off the pace, raced between foes into the turn, angled five wide around the bend and failed to rally. H Q WILSON lost a clear path and was forced in early, traveled near the back from off the rail, navigated the turn two to three wide, angled to the inside in the stretch and failed to menace. TEXAS WILDCAT got crowded in the early stages, raced four deep off the pace leaving the backstretch, traveled six deep at the quarter pole, came seven wide into the lane and weakened. MISSILE CRUISER chased along the inside into the turn, fell out of range while moving into the two path and faded in the drive. COSMIC TRAIL chased outside a rival towards the rear, fell back to last on the turn, went five wide into the stretch and failed to menace.

BALTIC FIRE settled outside a rival, went three deep into the backstretch, drew closer from outside, bid three deep approaching the quarter pole, grabbed the lead at the top of the stretch, led clear into the final furlong, challenged by PUBLIC ASSEMBLY past the sixteenth pole and was able to hold on. PUBLIC ASSEMBLY unhurried in the early going and steered to the inside, moved into range on the far turn, given her cue while tipping out into the stretch, split foes past the eighth pole, rallied inside BALTIC FIRE in deep stretch, gained inch by inch to the wire but ran out of ground. RAW ABILITY (IRE) steered to the inside trailing the field, shifted to the two path at the quarter pole, steered out into the stretch, rallied from outside but could not get by MAY DAY READY for third. CERTITUDE (FR) stepped to the front and set tone along the fence, took pressure early on the backstretch, dueled with RESOLVE around the far turn then vied with outer pair past the quarter pole, relinquished the lead at the top the stretch, failed to kick on with the winner into the final furlong and weakened in the late stages. RESOLVE stalked in the two path, joined CERTITUDE (FR) on the backstretch, fought on even terms around the far turn, vied between late on the bend, could not keep pace with the winner in upper stretch and also weakened. SAQQARA SANDS (GB) showed early foot then raced keenly behind CERTITUDE (FR) on the clubhouse turn, stalked the top pair up the backstretch, drafted behind the leader saving ground through the far turn, roused approaching the stretch and tired in the final furlong.

LUBIES PRINCE broke a bit slow, trailed from inside, angled four wide around the bend, entered the lane in the three path and was never a factor.

set the tone early, remained unchallenged through the turn, asked right handed at the top of the lane, continued clear into the final furlong, got run down by the winner at the sixteenth pole and stayed on for a clear second. AMORITA chased outside TAHINI leaving the backstretch, navigated the turn two to three wide, angled widest at the top of the stretch, drew alongside CAN'T SLEEP late and got up at the wire. CAN'T SLEEP dueled briefly outside SARATOGA SPECIAL (IRE) then cleared to show the way up the backstretch, led in the two path then along the rail on the turn, continued clear into the last sixteenth, came under threat from AMORITA and got nailed on the line. TAHINI was off slow to begin, moved forward from inside, hugged the rail to the stretch, finished willingly through the lane and earned the show honors. PRINCESA MOCHE (PER) chased from off the pace, saved ground through the turn, moved out a bit in the lane and summoned a mild rally to round out the superfecta. KUWAITYA (IRE) stalked the lone leader in the two path, asked right handed at the top of the stretch, chased determinedly through the lane but finished evenly late. LISTENUPSHANCE stalked the pacesetter for a bit then moved up to apply pressure from outside, headed MAD HOUSE at the five-sixteenths pole, inched ahead at the quarter pole, put that rival away turning for home, continued clear into the final sixteenth, came under serious threat MAXIMUM BOURBON late but was able to hold on. MAXIMUM BOURBON chased the top pair from inside, remained on the fence to the stretch, angled out and took aim at LISTENUPSHANCE in the final furlong, dug in late and just missed. MOONLIGHT lagged behind the field early, angled out into the stretch, closed well through the lane and got by MAD HOUSE late to earn third. MAD HOUSE sprinted clear and crossed over then took pressure from LISTENUPSHANCE, headed by that rival midway around the bend, relinquished the lead shortly after, could not keep up into the stretch, drifted out in the lane while still trying and lost third late. DR. VENKMAN settled off the pace, ridden along the rail then in the two path on the turn and could not summon the needed rally in the stretch. STRONGHOLD traveled in mid-pack from off the rail, took the turn three wide and failed to rally. GOLD SWEEP settled outside STRONGHOLD early, traveled four wide on the turn before having to alter out sharply around CORNUCOPIAN at the quarter pole and could not threaten after. CORNUCOPIAN chased after the top pair outside a rival, sustained an injury nearing the quarter pole, pulled up shortly after and was transported off the track via equine ambulance.

LADY IN PARIS (GB) stalked along the inside, drafted behind the leader through the far turn, tipped out for a clear run at the top of the stretch, bid between rivals with a furlong remaining, drifted out late to bother a pair of rivals, fought with TAKE ANOTHER CARD into the closing moments and got up at the wire. TAKE ANOTHER CARD traveled outside a rival in the second flight, crept closer on the backstretch, angled five wide around the far turn, rallied widest in the lane, took over midstretch, dueled with LADY IN PARIS (GB) and got edged on the line. MIDNIGHT HORIZON (IRE) was off a bit slow from the inside, traveled between rivals at the back early, tugged on heels leaving the backstretch, went two then three wide around the bend, angled out for the drive, finished well outside the top pair late and kept gaining to the wire. MISO PHANSY raced in mid-pack on the inside, moved into range leaving the backstretch, rounded the far turn two, three, then four wide, rallied between rivals, got bumped and steadied late, then got edged for third. AMERICA'S MARK was antsy inside the gate, grabbed the early lead and controlled the pace in the opening stages, remained clear through the far turn, roused at the top of the lane, challenged at the eighth pole, lost command midstretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. UPCHARGE sat off the pace on the inside, chased between in range through the stretch but failed to find more late. YOGA MASTER (GB) tracked in the two path out of range early, moved forward three deep approaching the far turn, continued three wide into the stretch, challenged from between runners, then bumped when crowded and checked late and was too late to recover. KIKURIDE broke well then dropped back on the inside, coaxed along through the far turn and failed to menace. QUANTUM INNERGY raced outside a pair of rivals at the back, picked up stride while angling out on the far turn, spun six wide into the stretch and weakened. BETTE DAVIS EYES (IRE) stalked in the two path, chased between runners still two wide on the second bend and faded through the lane. THERE WAS AN INQUIRY INVOLVING THE STRETCH RUN BETWEEN SEVERAL RUNNERS.
