PIONEER PRINCE was closest in pursuit early on, drew alongside the leader on the backstretch, seized control approaching the far turn, cleared midway around the bend, opened up into the stretch, powered away under a drive and was in hand nearing the wire. MONGOLIAN MAX laid off the pace in the three path, spun four wide into the stretch, produced a mild rally and edged MICI'S EXPRESS for second. MICI'S EXPRESS tracked in the two path, three deep around the far turn, was closest in pursuit of the runaway winner into the final furlong, churned on through the late stages and got nailed for second. ROYAL 'N RANDO trailed along the inside, passed rivals into the stretch, moved out past the eighth pole, steadied midstretch and kept on to round out the

superfecta. CUPID'S CRUSADER chased from inside, asked between rivals in the two path on the far turn and faded in the drive. CATHAL (IRE) traveled off the pace in the three path around the first turn, stayed off the rail to the far turn, exited that bend in the four path and failed to menace. SUNSET STORM showed the way early, took pressure at the nine-sixteenths pole, lost command nearing the far turn, yielded at the five-sixteenths pole, chased on the inside into the lane and weakened. LEVON raced in the two path near the back, raced on the inside then returned to the two path on the far turn and was never a factor. OOBUBBAKAYO settled along the inside, asked through the far turn and came up empty when called upon. SHORTMAN dropped off the pace in the two path, trailed three wide turning for home and could not make an impact.
