NOKIE away well, stalked from outside, made a four wide move to challenge the top trio leaving the bend, cleared into the last sixteenth and held safely. BUDS N SUDS dropped back early, trailed off the rail then angled in for the turn, passed a rival around the bend, angled out into the lane, closed well through the lane and drew alongside the leader late but ran out of ground. RYTHEM GIRL sat off the pace in the two path, eased out to the five path around the turn, finished well and earned the show honors. HEADED FOR OM bobbled and brushed at the start, prominent early outside the top pair, put a head in front three deep at the quarter pole, lost command with a furlong remaining and weakened in the last sixteenth. ROCK N ROLL SONG brushed HEADED FOR OM at the start, pressed the pace from outside, fought between rivals at the quarter pole, fought to upper stretch and weakened. A ROUSING BABE followed in range along the inside into the turn, shifted to the two path at the quarter pole, moved out further in the drive and weakened. VICTORIA'S JEWEL showed the way under pressure, headed midway around the turn, lost the lead at the quarter pole and faded down the lane. SUPER ELLIE bobbled at the start, chased from off the pace three deep then outside a rival, entered the turn in the three path, dropped to last on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and was never a factor.

JACKLYN LUCAS trailed on the inside into the first turn, moved off the fence on the backstretch, advanced three then four wide around the far turn, overhauled the top pair midstretch and won going away. CHRISTEL CLEAN fought inside rival into the first turn for command and grabbed the lead around the bend, lost command dueling with LINO'S ANGEL on the backstretch, regained the lead early on the far turn, battled into the final furlong, yielded to the winner midstretch and held second over LINO'S ANGEL late. LINO'S ANGEL showed speed between rivals then followed CHRISTEL CLEAN from outside around the first turn, went up to put a head in front of CHRISTEL CLEAN on the backstretch, gave the lead back to the rival early on the far turn, fought gamely into the final furlong, also yielded to the winner midstretch and got outfinished for second. BERRY VALLEY sat off the pace in the two path then found the rail on the clubhouse turn, chased in the two path once again on the far turn, steered out in upper stretch, kept trying in the final furlong but could not threaten. DORIE MILLER got squeezed back at the start, chased three then two wide around the first turn outside a rival, drew closer in the middle stages, rounded the far turn in the two path then along the rail and weakened in the drive. PAVEL'S ETOILE raced up close three deep into the first turn, dropped back three then four wide on the far turn, tired and eased in the lane and walked off. CECILIA STREET broke the stall doors open, backed out and reloaded, showed early foot but got crowded between the leaders into the first turn, angled over to the rail in pursuit, started to weaken around the far turn, also tired and eased in the lane and walked off.

GOLDEN SENTRY chased along the inside, got put in a bit tight momentarily at the quarter pole but was able to get through without losing momentum, tipped out for a clear look at the leader, collared that rival at the eighth pole, seized control midstretch and won going away. CHISELED IN STONE sprinted clear from inside, showed the way unchallenged into the stretch, collared by GOLDEN SENTRY at the eighth pole, offered little resistance to that rival and was able to stay on to secure second. GOLDEN CLUB stalked three deep then outside a rival into the turn, came under a ride around the bend, tipped out at the top of the lane, drifted in a bit at the eighth pole and kept on for a clear third. ENJOY THE RIDE traveled along the inside near the back, lacked room when boxed in early on the turn to past the five-sixteenths marker, shifted between rivals at the quarter pole, angled back to the inside at the eighth pole and improved position. INSTINCTIVELY traveled outside a rival from out of range, moved into the three path on the turn and never responded to urging. DIAMOND TORNADO chased two wide into the turn, started to weaken on the turn, found the rail at the quarter pole faded in the lane. HAUNTED HOUSE broke a step slow then steadied when losing a clear path shortly after, trailed outside a rival into the turn, rounded the bend two then three wide and weakened. RAPID THIRSTY laid off the pace on the inside, saved ground to the stretch and was never a factor.

ATOMIC AGE well placed from inside, waited behind the leader through the final furlong, entered the lane in the two path, tipped out and launched a bid at the top of the lane, collared the leader with a furlong remaining, put a head in front outside the sixteenth pole and drove clear. POOR CONNECTION raced up close in the two path or to the outside of the leader, applied pressured around the clubhouse turn, dueled leaving the backstretch, took over past the quarter pole, put FOMO JOE away in upper stretch, challenged by the winner at the eighth pole, lost the lead with a sixteenth remaining and held second. MYTHICAL REEL (IRE) tracked along the rail then moved to the two path around the first turn, waited around the third turn still in the two path, came under a ride in the stretch and outkicked GROGU for third. GROGU trailed on the inside through the first two turns, went outside a rival on the backstretch, advanced three deep on the far turn and finished evenly late. RIMPROTECTOR settled inside, drew closer on the backstretch, hugged the rail to the stretch, then moved off the fence and failed to threaten. LIVING LIFE unhurried outside a rival in the opening stages, traveled on the rail around the clubhouse turn, trailed into the final bend, tipped out at the top of the lane, lacked room behind rivals in upper stretch and failed to menace. FOMO JOE broke well to take the front, moved inside, pressured around the clubhouse turn, fought on even terms into the final furlong, lost the lead past the quarter pole, yielded in upper stretch and retreated. SIR PERCIVAL stalked three wide around the first turn, moved into the two path first time through the stretch, asked three deep at the quarter pole and faded out of contention.

ZADRA pressed between early, got bumped and put in tight past the half-mile pole, chased two then three wide on the turn, moved out in the lane, drew alongside I'M NO SWIFTY at the sixteenth pole, put a head in front and held gamely between rivals. ANYA chased widest in the early going, bumped inner

rival early on the turn, went four to five wide around the bend, rallied three deep into the last sixteenth and got outclosed by the winner. I'M NO SWIFTY fought for the lead outside several rivals early, vied three deep on the turn, regained the lead at the quarter pole, led clear into the final furlong, challenged by outer rivals in deep stretch and yielded. LOW LA BUNNY showed early foot between rivals, got bumped and pinched back past the half-mile pole, advanced along the rail then in the two path on the turn, tipped out, rallied down the lane but lacked room when lost a clear path at the sixteenth pole and could not regain momentum after. SOPHIA MIJA raced up close between rivals then got bumped and pinched back past the half-mile pole, chased two wide then along the rail, tipped out for the stretch and improved position. SNAPSHOT stumbled leaving the gate, lacked early speed, angled to the inside, steered out on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and produced a mild rally to advance but failed to threaten. SISSEL vied four deep up the backstretch then moved into the two path fighting between rivals into the turn, fought two wide around the bend, yielded into the stretch and weakened down the lane. LAST CHANCE DARCY vied inside several rivals early, fought with outer duo into the turn, took over early on the bend, gave the lead back at the quarter pole, yielded into the stretch and weakened. STYLISH COLLEEN chased from off the rail, steadied briefly at the seven-sixteenths pole, bumped with outer rival early on the turn, angled from the four path to the two path and lacked a rally. GRIEVOUS ANGEL showed early speed between, drifted in and bumped a rival past the half-mile pole, dropped back three then four wide on the turn and tired. VALENTINA JAN was off slow to begin, moved into range quickly, sustained an injury past the half-mile pole, pulled up early on the turn and was transported off the track via equine ambulance. THERE WAS AN INQUIRY INVOLVING SEVERAL RIVALS PAST THE HALF-MILE POLE. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS UNANIMOUSLY RULED THAT THE RUNNERS INVOLVED WERE RACING IN TIGHT QUARTERS AND NO ONE RUNNER COULD BE BLAMED SO THERE WOULD BE NO CHANGE. THE SECOND INQUIRY INVOLVED THE INCIDENT AT THE SIXTEENTH POLE BETWEEN ZADRA, I'M NO SWIFTY AND LOW LA BUNNY. FOLLOWIN A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS UNANIMOUSLY RULED THAT THE INCIDENT DID NOT WARRANT A DISQUALIFICATION.
