Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

FACTOR P showed the way under pressure from outer rival, moved clear at the three-eighths pole, roused turning for home, drifted from the left hand midstretch and stayed clear to the wire. GENUINE GRACE gave chase from off the pace, picked up stride while angling off the rail around the bend, went three wide into the lane, finished well through the stretch and kept gaining on the winner to the wire. SALLY SAYS bobbled a bit leaving the gate, chased from off the pace staying away from the rail, took the turn three then four wide and gained third. HAYLEY AMBER dropped back early and angled in, traveled two wide then along the fence on the turn, improved position in the lane but failed to threaten. MUSTANG KNICKY pressed the pace up the backstretch, failed to keep up with the winner on the turn, chased two wide into the lane and flattened out. NATIVE EMPRESS raced in mid-pack early, went between rivals into the turn, rounded the bend two then three wide and failed to rally. QUICK SIP was off slow to begin and trailed the field, took the turn two to three wide and was never a factor.
