MR. A. P. was closest in pursuit on or a bit off the rail in the early going, came under a ride on the far turn in the two path, grabbed the lead with a furlong remaining and drove clear in deep stretch. VITRUVIAN MAN trailed on the inside, outside a rival on the backstretch, two then three wide on the far turn, angled out into the stretch, came with late run and got up for second. ZEUS'S ECHO showed the way from inside, ridden along through the far turn, challenged by MR. A. P. in upper stretch, gave the lead up at the eighth pole and got edged for second late. IRISEACH (IRE) took shortly after the start, tracked from inside, saved ground to the stretch, moved off the fence in the lane and went evenly late. OTTIS BETTS became rank for a bit shortly after the start and bumped inner rival, settled on the inside, trailed through the far turn and never threatened. CARO BUONO (FR) tracked the top pair outside a rival, rounded the far turn two then three wide and weakened.

GHOSTWRITTEN dueled from inside, ceded command on the backstretch, joined GALLATIN again leaving the backstretch, put a head in front dueling around the far turn, carried a short lead into the final furlong, put GALLATIN away at the sixteenth pole and won going away. GALLATIN dueled from outside, took control when GHOSTWRITTEN ceded command on the backstretch, headed by that rival approaching the far turn, lost the lead dueling around the bend, fought to midstretch, then yielded to the winner with a sixteenth remaining but was clearly second best. AFTER DAWN followed in range three then two wide around the first turn, asked while staying in the three path on the far turn and never responded to urging. YAUTOWN was off slow to start, raced outside a rival at the back then between rivals early, moved into range in the middle stages, dropped back in the two path then along the rail on the far turn and weakened in the drive. PERFECTIONACHIEVED tracked four deep into the first turn then quickly moved to the three path, dropped back to last, passed a rival while staying off the rail on the far turn and was never a factor. LIKE AND SUBSCRIBE settled along the rail, drew closer in the middle stages, fell back to last on the far turn and had little left for the drive.

LESS PLEASE settled outside rivals, closed in three then two wide on the turn, drew alongside the leader turning for home, surged clear shortly after, tapped with the left hand past the eighth pole, ridden out into the final sixteenth and geared down late. SAUCED UP gave chased from inside out of range, drew closer around the bene, moved off the fence in the driven, finished willingly to gain second but could not threaten the winner. TIGER LUCK saved ground from off the pace, elected to stay on the inside in the lane and ran on for the show. FIRST TIME LISTING unhurried in the beginning, raced outside a rival towards the rear, traveled two wide then along the rail on the turn, steered out in the lane and kept on to round out the superfecta. PRINCESS LUNA was off slow when bumping with outer rival, began to make progress but had to steady behind rivals at the half-mile pole, navigated the turn three then four wide and lacked a rally. VONNTASTIC broke slow and got bumped at the start, trailed three wide, angled out at the top of the lane and passed tired rivals. KATHY'S HOUSE jumped out to a bit lead early, carried a diminishing lead into the final quarter of a mile, collared by the winner at the three-sixteenths pole and folded once overtaken. THIRSTY ELUSIVE broke well, was closest in pursuit from the two path early, chased two wide around the bend and weakened down the lane. VAHEVALA chased two wide leaving the backstretch, had to take up behind THIRSTY ELUSIVE at the three-eighths pole and weakened.

BIT'S TIGER MAGIC showed speed outside rivals then cleared and crossed over, kicked away in upper stretch, carried a comfortable lead into the final sixteenth and held safely. RETHINK sat off the pace and moved inside, angled out past the quarter pole, spun four wide into the lane, finished well and outkicked LEE'S BABY GIRL for second. LEE'S BABY GIRL chased in the two path, angled four wide late on the bend, moved into second midstretch but got outkicked by RETHINK for the place honors late. YOUNG LOVE unhurried in the beginning, traveled outside a rival at the back, steered out to the five path late on the bend and summoned mild rally. VISUALLY trailed on the inside, hugged the rail through the turn, roused at the three-sixteenths pole, angled out in the lane and passed tired rivals. MISS MANDALAY (GB) raced up close in the two path inside the leader, had to pause when that rival crossed in front leaving the backstretch, pursued in the two path between runners on the turn, then faded down the lane. KUWAITYA (IRE) stalked three deep into the turn, remained in the three path to the stretch and weakened. A. Z. WILDCAT showed early foot but got put in tight and steadied at the half-mile pole, recovered quickly and remained forwardly placed along the rail, saved ground to the stretch and tired.

VAN GOGH STYLE dueled from inside up the backstretch and around the turn, shook free in upper stretch and drew away. CORNEALEUSTHEGREAT got crowded and had to take up early, raced outside a rival at the back then angled in with one rival beat leaving the backstretch, rallied up the rail then steered out in the last sixteenth to get up for second. MICKEY sat off the pace in the early going, went two wide into the turn, tipped three wide approaching the

five-sixteenths pole, angled out and came five wide into the stretch and rallied to earn third. GABRIEL'S GIFT broke in, bumped with FINE IRISH MORNING early, stalked the top pair to the turn, challenged three deep on the turn, could not match strides with the winner in upper stretch and flattened out deep stretch. PAPA SANTOS broke well, stalked two wide into the turn, chased between runners then came three wide into the stretch, angled out at the eighth pole and never threatened. SEAVER WAY raced off the pace on the inside, chased two wide into the lane, three deep at the eighth pole and failed to menace. HE'S PROOF OF JOY was in range early from inside, lost ground through the turn under urging and faded in the drive. FINE IRISH MORNING broke inward, bumped with GABRIEL'S GIFT early, chased three deep on the turn, drifted inward in the lane and tired. ONE MORE ZINGER away quickest from the outside, dueled for the lead with VAN GOGH STYLE up the backstretch and around the turn, yielded between rivals approaching the stretch and retreated. TIGER TO YOU got put in tight and checked early, trailed into the turn, angled from the two path to the four path around the bend and was never a factor. RACK ON MAN bothered from outside leaving the gate, climbed along early while in mid-pack, lost positions three then four wide on the turn and had little left for the stretch run.
