MR. A. P. was closest in pursuit on or a bit off the rail in the early going, came under a ride on the far turn in the two path, grabbed the lead with a furlong remaining and drove clear in deep stretch. VITRUVIAN MAN trailed on the inside, outside a rival on the backstretch, two then three wide on the far turn, angled out into the stretch, came with late run and got up for second. ZEUS'S ECHO showed the way from inside, ridden along through the far turn, challenged by MR. A. P. in upper stretch, gave the lead up at the eighth pole and got edged for second late. IRISEACH (IRE) took shortly after the start, tracked from inside, saved ground to the stretch, moved off the fence in the lane and went evenly late. OTTIS BETTS became rank for a bit shortly after the start and bumped inner rival, settled on the inside, trailed through the far turn and never threatened. CARO BUONO (FR) tracked the top pair outside a rival, rounded the far turn two then three wide and weakened.
