MEGA MOON bobbled leaving the gate, followed in range from inside, roused at the quarter pole, tipped out into the lane, challenged in upper stretch. TESSUTO stepped to the front and moved to the two path, controlled the pace to the far turn, led along the inside around that bend, challenged by MEGA MOON in upper stretch, yielded to that rival midstretch and kept on for a clear second. LURE HIM IN laid off the pace on the inside, steered out on the backstretch, traveled three then four wide on the far turn, drifted into the lane, offered a mild response and ran by rivals to gain third. THE GYPSY COWBOY broke a step slow, trailed on the inside, passed a rival while also easing off the rail around the far turn, went three wide into the stretch, angled out and could not rally. PIONEER PRINCE stalked the speed outside a rival asked at the three-eighths pole, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. CONCORD BRIDGE tracked out of range in the two path, asked three then four wide on the far turn, drifted in at the eighth pole and weakened.
