JALISCO vied inside several rivals to the turn holding a slim advantage, lost the lead at the quarter pole, battled back into the final furlong, regained the lead and gamely prevailed. STANFORD DROPOUT vied three deep between early, dueled outside JALISCO on the turn, put a head in front at the quarter pole, battled through the lane and got outgamed by the winner. EIELSON chased after the top hexad while angling to the inside, pursued the dueling leaders around the turn still on the fence, asked right handed turning for home, could not make up any ground but kept on to best the rest. CRUCIBLE vied four deep between rivals, got put in tight at the seven-sixteenths pole, angled to the rail now trailing on the turn, steered out in upper stretch and passed tired rivals. ORIGINAL ONE fought for the lead between rivals, got crowded into the turn, chased two wide around the bend and could not rally. CHASE N RYAN vied five deep to the turn, dropped back three then four wide around the bend and faded. JOKER WENT WILD vied six deep in the early going, could not keep up and chased four then three wide on the turn and weakened.

OGLE broke a step slow, trailed from inside, drew closer while easing over to the two path on the far turn, shifted out into the stretch, rallied four deep into the final furlong, took over shortly after and kicked clear to win going away. LET HER FLY took control and crossed over to the inside, pressured by JANIE NOT JEANIE midway around the bend, maintained command through the far turn, resisted to the eighth pole, then yielded to the winner and managed to hold second. VINTAGE QUEEN stalked in the two path, bid three deep on the far turn, fought between rivals past the eighth pole but was no match in the last sixteenth. VENDETTA stalked along the rail, followed behind the leader through the far turn, lacked room from upper to midstretch, angled out nearing the sixteenth pole and kept trying to the wire. JANIE NOT JEANIE raced up close along the rail, shifted out and drew alongside the leader on the clubhouse turn, fought on even terms turning for home, vied between midstretch and weakened in the last sixteenth. MISS PARISIAN traveled outside a rival at the back, moved into range on the backstretch, went three wide into the far turn, made a four wide move around the bend but flattened out int he final furlong.

AH JEEZ traveled near the back on the inside, moved out and was on the move three deep in the middle stages, challenged the top pair from outside into the far turn, vied three deep to the lane, took over in upper stretch, cleared midstretch and was kept busy to the wire. MARY'S BOY BOLT tracked in the two path around the first turn, raced along the rail into the far turn, moved back to the two path at the quarter pole, steered out in the lane to take aim at the leaders, rallied for second but could not get to the winner. ZALAMO (FR) sat off the pace in the early going, crept closer on the backstretch, raced a bit off the rail on the far turn, finished willingly through the lane and earned the show honors. LAHAINA FLAVOR trailed from inside early, rounded the far turn in the two path, steered out in the lane and finished well to earn a minor award. MUBTADAA forwardly placed from inside, bid between runners at the seven-sixteenths marker, took a short lead around the far turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and flattened to fifth. UNCLE HAPPY reserved along the rail early, roused two wide on the second bend but failed to rally. DEALERS SPECIAL raced in mid-pack outside a rival, moved into range leaving the backstretch, angled out on the far turn, spun four wide into the lane and never responded to urging. DOUBLE NEAT showed the way from inside, challenged by a pair of rivals at the seven-sixteenths pole, lost command at the three-eighths pole, fought back to upper stretch, then weakened in the furlong grounds. PHOSPHORESCENCE (FR) traveled in mid-pack on the inside, continued out of range to the far turn, saved ground staying on the fence

and failed to menace.

HUMIDITY pulled three deep prior to the first turn then settled in the two path, remained two wide to the stretch, then steered out to unleash a rally, closed in from outside and proved best under hand urging. DANZING DAISY stalked three deep early, was closest in pursuit entering the far turn, challenged in the two path then between rivals around the bend, led into the final furlong, carried a clear lead with a sixteenth remaining but yielded to the winner late. NANCY TWO POINT O settled outside a pair of rivals, asked four deep leaving the backstretch, ranged up three deep on the far turn, fought to the eighth pole, lacked the needed late punch but stayed on to hold third. KITTY MAC ran up on heels and checked prior to the first turn, rated between around the first turn, followed in range in the two path to the stretch and finished evenly through the lane to round out the superfecta. PRINCESSES PHOEBE bobbled and broke

in, pulled early in the two path then moved inside, lacked room from upper to midstretch, roused at the sixteenth pole and could not threaten. BARRA ROZA tucked inside at the rear, hugged the rail to the stretch, moved out in the lane and passed tired rivals. UNUSUAL CRAVING tracked three wide in hand early, ridden along still in the three path on the far turn and failed to respond in the lane. AMOR SECRETO set the pace in the two path then moved inside, took pressure early on the far turn, resisted to upper stretch, lost the lead at the eighth pole and weakened. RISKY PLEASURE stalked along the rail, roused outside the quarter pole, lacked room and steadied at the eight pole, then weakened in the late stages.
