HARMONIQUE showed the way from the two path around the first turn, took pressure from WOLF HILL on the backstretch, kept a short lead over that rival through the far turn, edged clear at the eighth pole, drew away under urging and was in hand approaching the wire. WOLF HILL stalked three then two wide around the first turn, drew alongside HARMONIQUE on the backstretch, fought with that rival to upper stretch, then failed to kick on with the winner in the furlong grounds but was able to hold second. APPLES Y PEACHES was prominent early along the fence, asked past the three-eighths pole, angled out into the lane, kept trying through the final furlong but lacked the needed late punch. RABID RESPONSE tracked along the inside around the first turn, chased two then three wide on the second bend, tipped wider into the stretch and weakened. BOURBON STORY chased two wide into the first turn then lugged out early on the bend, dropped back to last, exited the backstretch in the three path, angled to the two path, passed a rival while drifting a bit late on the bend and could not rally. SWIMMINGLY tracked the speed outside a rival, raced keenly in hand on the first turn and early on the backstretch, moved forward in the middle stages, started to weaken three then four wide on the far turn, got floated five wide late on the bend and had little left for the stretch.

DANG SON broke in and got bumped by outer rival, settled inside, moved off the rail on the backstretch, was on the move in the four path around the far turn, took aim in upper stretch, forced out a bit by bumping leaders past the eighth pole, dug in the last sixteenth and edged clear nearing the line. AUTOMATIC PRESS grabbed the early lead and moved inside, challenged by CLEAR AND PRESENT with three furlongs remaining, dueled into the stretch, shifted out and bumped CLEAR AND PRESENT twice inside the eighth pole, resisted into the final sixteenth, then yielded to the winner late. WILDCATTER was off a bit slow to begin, stalked keenly in hand on the inside before settling on the backstretch, flanked the leader into the far turn but got put in tight early on the bend, stayed on the fence to the stretch, finished willingly through the lane and edged CLEAR AND PRESENT for the show. CLEAR AND PRESENT raced up close in the two path, bid from outside at the three-eighths pole, dueled through the turn and into the lane, got bumped by AUTOMATIC PRESS twice inside the eighth pole, fought between with a sixteenth remaining and could not summon the needed final kick. LUBIES PRINCE was off slow to begin, tracked from the two path in the early going, chased between runners still in the two path on the far turn, remained close through the lane but finished evenly late. ITINERARY broke in and bumped, tucked inside at the back, crept closer inside a rival in the middle stages, angled out into the stretch, chased out of range into the final sixteenth, then showed good late energy to close the gap. OSCAR STORM stalked three deep to the far turn, started to weaken around the bend and tired in the drive. THERE WAS AN INQUIRY INVOLVING AUTOMATIC PRESS AND CLEAR AND PRESENT IN THE STRETCH RUN. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS UNANIMOUSLY RULED TO DISQUALIFY AUTOMATIC PRESS FROM SECOND TO FOURTH FOR SHIFTING OUT AND BUMPING CLEAR AND PRESENT TWICE, COSTING THAT RIVAL A CHANCE AT A BETTER PLACING.

VANCOUGAR sprinted clear and crossed over, drew off around the turn under coaxing, continued to widen into the final furlong and remained far in front under right handed urging and steady handling. B GRAYSON climbed early and dropped back to last, traveled in the two path into the turn, angled five wide around the bend, offered a mild rally and bested the rest. WILL BE got put in a bit tight briefly at the start by VANCOUGAR, chased after that rival three deep, came under a ride while watching the winner open up and failed to answer the call. ROBARANDO broke through the gate, brought back around and reloaded, chased after the lone speed between rivals, fell well out of range on the turn and weakened in the drive. FUEGO DEL SOL got bumped in the hindquarters leaving the gate, chased after the winner inside a pair of rivals, lost ground through the turn and had little left for the drive. LEAD PIPE JOE broke out and bumped FUEGO DEL SOL, raced off the pace four wide into the turn, dropped back to last around the bend while moving out to the six path and came up empty in the lane.

THE MIZEN QUEEN (IRE) tracked in the three path on the first turn, moved inside running through the lane first time, closed to within striking distance on the backstretch, challenged in the two path late on the far turn, put a head in front briefly midstretch, was quickly overtaken by VRONTI (GB) and stayed on to hold second. PULP FICTION (ARG) away quickly then ceded command to LUBIE'S MUSIC, came back to take the lead entering the stretch for the first time, cleared and moved to the rail, overtaken by LUBIE'S MUSIC on the backstretch and dueled with that rival to the far turn, could not keep up at the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back around the final turn, eased in the lane and walked off. STEAK FRIES was prominent early along the rail, applied pressure to the leader around the clubhouse turn, took over exiting the bend, gave the lead back to KNOWN IDEA on the backstretch, lost touch with that rival into the far turn, switched to the outside and reengaged on the far turn, fought on even terms turning for home, put a nose in front entering the final furlong, inched ahead with a sixteenth remaining and drove clear late. EL REY REY traveled in mid-pack inside, saved ground through the far turn, rallied up the fence and got by KNOWN IDEA for second. KNOWN IDEA traveled in the two path trading the lead with STEAK FRIES early, cleared into the far turn and moved inside, challenged again by that rival around the far turn, dueled into the stretch, lost the lead at the eighth pole, fought back into deep stretch, yielded late and got edged for second. CANANI laid off the pace on the inside, saved ground to the stretch, set down at the top of the lane, came with a late rally and rounded out the superfecta. IRISH PROPHET traveled three deep towards the rear into the first turn, went between rivals in the two path past the half-mile marker, eased out to the four path around the bend, steered out further in the lane and showed late effort. LYLE THE CROCODILE (IRE) tracked three then two wide early, fell out of range on the backstretch, roused in the two path on the far turn, tipped out at the top of the stretch, chased between rivals through the lane but failed to find more. BEYOND STOKED raced between rivals then two wide towards the back of the pack, navigated the far turn three wide, steered out in the lane and never threatened. YACOWLEF (IRE) tracked the pace from inside, fell out of range on the backstretch, drew closer still next to the fence on the far turn, came off the rail at the top of the lane and failed to summon the needed late kick. SARWAR (FR) trailed the field along the inside, advanced four deep around the far turn but flattened out in the late stages. T'CHALLA (GB) settled in the two path, raced outside a rival at the back leaving the far turn and was never a factor.
