HARMONIQUE showed the way from the two path around the first turn, took pressure from WOLF HILL on the backstretch, kept a short lead over that rival through the far turn, edged clear at the eighth pole, drew away under urging and was in hand approaching the wire. WOLF HILL stalked three then two wide around the first turn, drew alongside HARMONIQUE on the backstretch, fought with that rival to upper stretch, then failed to kick on with the winner in the furlong grounds but was able to hold second. APPLES Y PEACHES was prominent early along the fence, asked past the three-eighths pole, angled out into the lane, kept trying through the final furlong but lacked the needed late punch. RABID RESPONSE tracked along the inside around the first turn, chased two then three wide on the second bend, tipped wider into the stretch and weakened. BOURBON STORY chased two wide into the first turn then lugged out early on the bend, dropped back to last, exited the backstretch in the three path, angled to the two path, passed a rival while drifting a bit late on the bend and could not rally. SWIMMINGLY tracked the speed outside a rival, raced keenly in hand on the first turn and early on the backstretch, moved forward in the middle stages, started to weaken three then four wide on the far turn, got floated five wide late on the bend and had little left for the stretch.
