LLAMP took a bump leaving the gate then another between rivals early on, bid between exiting the backstretch, fought two then three wide on the turn, put a head in front in upper stretch, cleared with a furlong remaining and held safely under urging. FAMOUS FORZA settled inside, dropped back to last on the turn, steered out and came four to five wide into the lane, tipped out further in upper stretch and rallied for second. EGYPTIAN MISTRESS trailed early from off the rail, passed a rival into the turn, angled out around the bend, spun five wide into the stretch, put in a bid, could not kick on with the winner in the final eighth and got edged for second. MUSICAL SONG followed the leader inside a pair of rivals, asked right handed on the turn, cut the corner into the lane, kept trying to the wire but needed to find more. BOURBON AND SPICE broke alertly and outward, grabbed the early lead and crossed over, pressured by a pair of rivals nearing the turn, carried a short lead along the rail then two wide into the stretch, gave up the lead outside the eighth pole and weakened. NOSOX broke in and bumped LLAMP, came in and bumped that rival again early, chased outside rivals then bid three deep into the turn, fought in the four path turning for home and weakened down the lane.
