BULL SHOALS brushed three deep leaving the chute, stalked in the three path into the first turn then moved over to the two path, drew closer three deep between on the backstretch, backed off a bit past the half-mile pole, commenced his run while angling four wide on the far turn, chased in the three path entering the lane, headed the leader at the eighth pole, took over shortly after and kicked clear to win going away. GOING NOWHERE dueled from outside then cleared inner rival and crossed over approaching the first turn, met bids from outer runners in the middle stages, moved clear again approaching the five-sixteenths pole, collared by BULL SHOALS at the eighth pole, yielded to that rival and stayed on to hold second. DOING TIME got bumped between rivals leaving the chute, settled inside, closed in on the far turn, took aim in upper stretch, was no match for the winner and failed to get by GOING NOWHERE for second. BIG VENGEANCE dueled from inside then ceded command to GOING NOWHERE running through the stretch for the first time, took a stalking position in the two path, challenged that rival at the half-mile pole, failed to keep up early on the far turn, chased in the two path around the bend and weakened in the lane. CHALKY'S GOLD brushed leaving the gate, trailed four wide leaving the chute, traveled three then two wide on the first turn, went outside a rival on the backstretch, remained two wide around the far turn, found the rail at the top of the stretch and could not rally. ROYAL RUMOR shifted out to bother rivals leaving the chute and was hard to handle in the early going, drifted out a bit on the first turn, made a middle move four then three deep to challenge for the lead, could not keep up and gave chase three wide on the far turn, then faded in the stretch run.

CHASING KAT pressed from outside, took over past the quarter pole, cleared rivals into the stretch, drew off under right handed urging to the sixteenth pole, then held safely over the late charge from the runner-up. PRETTY CECY bumped leaving the gate, coaxed along from off the pace staying well off the rail, exited the bend four to five wide, angled out further in the lane, closed well from outside and kept gaining to the wire. JASMINA got bumped at the start, raced up close three deep, challenged the top pair from outside on the turn, was no match for the winner in upper stretch, got passed for second and was able to hold third. RUNNING SUPER broke out and bumped, stalked between runners, had to check when running on the heels of CHASING KAT at the seven-sixteenths pole, went two wide into the turn, drifted out a bit around the bend and churned on for a minor award. LOVELY MEDAGLIA broke out, followed in range four deep, remained wide through the turn and flattened out. HOW LOVELY (IRE) broke out and bumped, was forwardly placed on the inside, cut the corner into the stretch and weakened. BEAR'S BOARD showed the way under pressure from the winner to the outside, headed by that rival at the quarter pole, lost command shortly after, came off the rail a bit leaving the turn and folded. STARS HOLLOW dropped off the pace, jumped tracks nearing the half-mile pole, trailed well off the rail on the turn and was never a factor.

CUPID COWBOY followed in range four then three deep early, rounded the bend three then four wide, rallied steadily from outside and got up in the final strides. LITTLE KING tracked between rivals then got crowded a bit past the nine-sixteenths pole, angled to the inside, gained ground through the turn, tipped out and challenged from outside in upper stretch, cleared with a sixteenth remaining, came under threat from CUPID COWBOY late and got passed in the closing moments. ANGEL'S EMBER raced keenly in hand briefly chasing the leader then went up to challenge from inside, took over past the half-mile pole, dueled around the turn, put SCAM ALERT at the top of the lane but was quickly confronted by LITTLE KING, yielded to that rival midstretch and flattened to third. EMPIRE OF ASH broke a step slow, had to take up between rivals shortly after, lagged behind to the quarter pole, rallied up the fence in the lane, then came out a bit late and earned a minor award. IS THAT YOU WING chased along the inside into the turn, shifted to the two path around the bend and flattened out in the furlong grounds. REPO pressed the leaders from outside, failed to keep up and chased three wide through the turn, then flattened out in the final furlong. SCAM ALERT stalked two wide or between rivals, went two to three wide into the lane, angled out and failed to rally. GOODTIMESNTANLINES stalked six then four deep up the backstretch, took the turn four then five wide and weakened in the lane. OLYMPIAN THIRST settled outside rivals then alongside a runner leaving the backstretch, took the turn two wide and failed to menace. VERN GOSDIN sprinted to the front then was confronted ANGEL'S EMBER, fought with that rival up the backstretch and around the turn, could not match strides in upper stretch and gave way.

HACKING IT UP followed in range outside a pair of rivals leaving the backstretch, loomed three wide turning for home, came in slightly while putting a head in front at the eighth pole, then edged clear from DISKO TRIBUTE in the last sixteenth. DISKO TRIBUTE bumped with inner rival at the start, took a short lead over outer pair, dueled with PIPER'S CAUSEWAY past the five-sixteenths pole, carried a short lead to upper stretch, overtaken by the winner at the eighth pole and stayed on for a game second. SCENE BY ME stalked two wide between rivals into the turn, found the rail around the bend, saved ground to the stretch, could not summon the needed but kept on to gain the show honors. KERRY GOLD brushed at the start, traveled outside a rival at the back early, went three deep around the bend, offered a mild response and earned a minor award. ITS A CINCH brushed with outer rival in the beginning, got crowded slightly along the rail and checked early, raced inside a rival at the back, chased in the two path between runners on the turn and failed to rally. WHYNOTANOTHERONE showed speed while coming in to bother a rival early, dueled from outside into the first turn, took a stalking position around the bend, took over dueling on the backstretch, inched ahead on the far turn, led clear into the stretch, drew off under right handed urging and remained clear to the wire. MY MAN JOE ROLDAN unhurried in the beginning, had to alter out sharply to avoid a fallen rider into the first turn, angled to the two path around the bend, advanced in the two path on the far turn, angled out in the lane and rallied for second. HOOSICK FALLS dueled from inside, took control around

the first turn, lost the lead dueling with WHYNOTANOTHERONE on the backstretch, fought inside that rival through the far turn, could not kick on with the leader into the stretch, churned on through the lane and earned third. LOW TOX forwardly placed three wide early, bid outside the top pair leaving the backstretch, failed to keep up and gave chase past the three-eighths pole, continued in the three path to the stretch and weakened. DISILLUSIONED settled on the outside, got forced eight wide into the first turn, steered inward to the three path, chased four deep at the back into the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and improved position. CANO FOR THE WIN hustled from the gate, tracked three wide early, angled in on the backstretch, lost ground next to the fence on the far turn and faded in the lane. WAR ARTIST was fractious in the gate, dropped back and moved inside, shifted to the two path on the far turn and was never a factor. KING OF SUCCESS got put in tight and checked early, stalked along the rail then moved to the two path, angled four wide around the far turn and weakened. H Q WILSON tracked three deep then got forced wide into the first turn by the riderless horse, steered down to the inside around the turn, went three deep into the second bend, trailed five wide approaching the stretch and passed a tired rival. RAPID ASCENT tracked the leaders from the four path, stayed away from the rail in the middle stages, started to weaken still wide on the far turn, eased in the lane and walked off. TEXAS WILDCAT got put in tight early, clipped heels and eventually unseated the rider who tried to hold on without his irons, came out to bother rivals into the first turn, ran around the outer portion of the track, eventually caught by the outrider on the far turn and walked off. THERE WAS AN INQUIRY INVOLVING WHYNOTANOTHERONE AND TEXAS WILDCAT EARLY IN THE RACE. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS UNANIMOUSLY RULED TO DISQUALIFY WHYNOTANOTHERONE FROM FIRST AND PLACE HIM UNPLACED FOR CROSSING IN FRONT OF TEXAS WILDCAT WITHOUT SUFFICIENT CLEARANCE, CAUSING THAT RIVAL TO CLIP HEELS AND UNSEAT HIS RIDER.

GOODIES showed the way early in the two path, set all the pace to the stretch and remained clear under mild urging to the wire. YOGA MASTER (GB) tracked from off the pace on the inside, moved into striking distance on the backstretch, followed behind GOODIES through the far turn, tipped out in upper stretch, chased determinedly through the lane but had to settle for second best. MISLEADING raced up close in the two path, went three deep into the far turn, quickly moved to the two path, could not offer the needed response in the stretch but was able to hold third. MISO PHANSY traveled on the inside near the back, steered out and gained from outside in the middle stages, pursued the leader four then three deep on the far turn but flattened out in the lane. COWBOY MIKE sprinted clear and crossed over, opened up around the far turn, roused at the top of the lane and maintained a comfortable lead under urging to the wire. BIG JUANITO settled along the inside then moved to the two path around the clubhouse turn, drew closer in hand between runners in the middle stages, rallied into second while traveling two to three wide on the far turn, drifted out while taking aim at the COWBOY MIKE in the stretch, could not summon the needed late kick but was clearly second best. LEYAS CANDY stalked three then four wide on the first turn, ridden along in the those same paths on the second bend, could not produce the needed rally but was able to save the show. TARIFF stalked along the inside, came under a ride at the halfway mark, got shuffled behind a rival on the far turn, tipped two wide and went around that one, kept trying down the lane but could not get by LEYAS CANDY for third. SHORTMAN trailed four wide early, outside a rival on the backstretch, went two wide into the far turn, angled back out to the four path

around the bend and passed tired rivals. NASTY HABIT broke well then settled out of range along the rail, traveled two wide on the turn, waited for room behind rivals at the top of the lane, gained an opening and given his cue, rallied into the final sixteenth and got by GABALDON late. GABALDON broke inward then straightened out and went to the front, showed the way unchallenged into the final sixteenth, then got run down by the winner late. SIR ROCKET allowed to settle off the pace and steered to

the inside, saved ground through the turn, came out at the top of the lane, showed late run and edged PRIVATE GEM for third. PRIVATE GEM stalked the pacesetter from inside, lost positions on the turn, stayed on the inside into the stretch, finished willingly from the fence but got edged at the wire for the show. DOUBLE JAB bobbled and brushed leaving the gate, stalked three deep between runners early, chased in the two path still between foes around the bend, pursued within striking distance down the stretch but finished evenly late. LEGAL HEIR stalked two wide between, moved to the rail for the turn once clear of inner rival, saved ground to the stretch, roused at the top of the lane, chased determinedly in the final furlong but also finished evenly. THE RABBI broke a step slow and dropped back, took the turn two wide, angled out into the stretch, produced a mild rally but failed to threaten. DHITJARI (GB) brushed at the start, raced three wide into the turn, angled down to the rail, steered back out in upper stretch and whittle the gap late. BULLWHACKER stalked four deep to the turn, went three deep around the bend, moved out in the drive and weakened. GETTINBY brushed with a rival in the beginning, chased from off the rail, took a bad step at the half-mile pole, eased out of the race, coasted through the turn, pulled up at the eighth pole and walked off.

REMEMBER APRIL bumped with outer rival at the start, followed in range three deep into the turn, took aim in the four path turning for home, drew alongside the top pair at the eighth pole, put a head in front with a sixteenth remaining and dug in to prevail. STYLISHLY BIG stalked three deep between rivals, vied three deep around the bend, took over at the top of the lane, fought with rivals into the final sixteenth but got outkicked by the winner. CHAMPAGNIA dueled from inside, held a short lead over an outer pair on the turn, lost command at the top of the stretch, fought back through the lane and finished a game third. LIST MY BIZ dueled from outside up the backstretch, fought between rivals on the turn, lost touch with the leaders turning for home, churned on through the lane and earned a minor award. WILLOW IN THE WIND chased two wide between early, moved inside at the quarter pole, cut the corner into the lane, kept trying from the fence but needed to find more. SHE'S BACK came out shortly after the start, stalked the dueling leaders four deep to the turn, chased five wide into the lane and lacked a rally. MELBA MONTGOMERY was off slow to begin, trailed two wide into the turn, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. PALACE MISCHIEF was off slow and bumped at the start, chased from off the pace, took the turn two to three wide, moved out in upper stretch and failed to rally. SOUTHERN RIFF broke slow and outward, stayed well off the rail up the backstretch, spun five wide into the lane and failed to menace. JOY THE IMAGE raced up close on the inside, started to weaken on the turn and faded in the drive. DIVA DAZZLE came out leaving the gate, tracked five wide leaving the backstretch, exited the bend in the six path and tired. LITTLE SANDY BEE saved ground from off the pace, moved off the fence in the lane and came up empty.
