BILLIE HOLIDAY took control from inside under pressure from TIMEKEEP'S CHARM, cleared that rival leaving the backstretch, padded the lead on the turn, drew off in upper stretch and was ridden out to the wire. BERRY VALLEY trailed well off the rail in the early going, took the turn four to five wide, rallied for second but failed to get near the winner. DOTTIE HINSON raced outside a rival or off the rail from off the pace, took the turn three to four wide and was along for third. SMILE BABY SMILE sat off the pace on the inside, asked around the bend and failed to menace. TIMEKEEPER'S CHARM pressed from outside in the early going, failed to keep up with the leader approaching the turn, rounded the bend three then two wide and faded down the lane. MARS MAGIC tracked from off rail, moved into the two path on the turn, shifted three wide into the lane and tired.
