TOASTER took a bump at the start, fought for the lead inside a pair of rivals up the backstretch, inched ahead on the turn, showed the way with a pair of rivals bearing down to the outside down the stretch and held gamely. FIRE BAN pressed the pace three deep to the quarter pole, lost touch with the leader into the stretch but remained close up, chased determinedly outside CLARINA through the lane but could not find the needed late kick. CLARINA stalked the top trio from inside, roused at the quarter pole, came off the rail in upper stretch, took aim at the leader in the final furlong but lacked the needed late punch. CLUBHOUSE CUTIE was antsy in the gate, unhurried in the opening stages, trailed on the inside around the bend, lacked room entering the lane, angled out with a furlong remaining, kept trying to earn a minor award but could not threaten the top trio. SCARY FAST RIDE followed in range between rivals, took the turn two then three wide and weakened down the lane. LA CHISMOSA stalked three deep to the turn, spun four wide into the lane and weakened. INTO THE HALL broke in and bumped TOASTER, dueled between rivals for early command, fought alongside the winner to the quarter pole, could not match strides turning for home and retreated.
