KNOWN IDEA broke out, pressed the pace from outside, moved up on even terms around the bend, drifted out and drew clear deep stretch. UNCLE CHILLY chased five deep to the turn, remained wide through the bend, rallied down the lane and gained second. CATMANSUE chased three deep between rivals early, asked three then two wide on the turn, followed within range into the final furlong and finished evenly late. TITANIC THOMPSON showed the way early under pressure from KNOWN IDEA to the outside, dueled around the turn, battled into the final furlong, drifted out and weakened late. BRUNCHANDCRUNCH broke a step slow, was guided out wide while climbing along at the back, went five wide into the turn, angled to the rail around the bend, put in a late run on the fence but was not enough. MINISTER SHANE raced in range four deep up the backstretch, remained four wide into the lane and weakened. KERRY GOLD climbed early from off the pace, moved to the inside, tipped out and came four wide into the lane but failed to threaten. JARAMA lost his path and steadied early, raced outside a rival into the turn, angled five wide around the bend and never responded to urging. RUNKERRY stalked from inside, ridden along into the turn, lost ground around the bend, moved off the fence in upper stretch and faded. LAST CALL LONDON chased the top pair from between rivals, dropped back on the turn, came three wide into the lane and tired.
