QUATTRO PASSI came away well then took a stalking position outside a rival, went three wide into the turn, challenged the leader from outside at the five-sixteenths pole, took over approaching the quarter pole, put TAMMYFAYE away leaving the bend, drew off under hand urging in upper stretch, continued to widen under left handed urging midstretch and was ridden out to the wire. PROSPECT OF LOVE stumbled leaving the gate, chased from off the pace on the inside, gained through the turn while easing out to the three path, finished well through the lane to gain second but was no match for the winner. AMERICAN SPIRIT coaxed along early near the back, saved ground through the turn, moved off the fence in upper stretch then came back to the inside and ran on to gain third. PACEMAKER chased the lone leader up the backstretch, ridden along in the two path on the turn and weakened down the lane. ROYAL PEARL chased out of range from off the rail, took the turn four wide and failed to respond in the stretch run. ROSAURA traveled in mid-pack staying away from the rail, exited the backstretch in the four path, angled in on the turn, traveled two wide turning for home and failed to menace. TAMMYFAYE sprinted to the front and crossed over, confronted by the winner at the five-sixteenths pole, lost command nearing the quarter pole, failed to fight back late on the bend and gave way in the drive. CANDY FOR JEANNE dropped back to last early, saved ground through the turn and could not make an impact.
