IRISEACH (IRE) settled next to the rail, tipped out late on the far turn, gained on the runner-up into deep stretch and drove past late. ARMY MAN stepped to the front on the inside, set all the pace to the top of the lane, remained clear under a drive into the last sixteenth but could not hold off the winner late. MEDICI stalked outside a rival or in the two path, came under a ride on the far turn, chased within striking distance down the stretch but finished evenly late. BIGGIEBIGGIEBIGGIE settled in the two path, moved into range on the backstretch, roused two then three wide on the far turn and lacked further response. LUCK LUCKY (IRE) stalked the lone speed inside a rival, hugged the rail to the stretch and weakened down the lane. PRIME ARTIST (FR) broke a bit slow, tucked inside at the back, passed a pair of rivals on the far turn and could not make an impact in the stretch run. MIGHTY TORO traveled outside rivals into the first turn then angled to the two path quickly on the bend, raced outside PRIME ARTIST (FR) at the rear to the far turn, trailed in the two path then had one rival beat while moving to the rail approaching the stretch and failed to be a factor. KID CHARLEMAGNE was hard to ride in the early going and went three wide around the clubhouse turn, tugged closer on the backstretch, weakened in the three path on the far turn and tired.

WESTERN FREEDOM bumped with outer rival at the start, raced up close behind the leader, saved ground through the turn, challenged from the fence midstretch and bested WINDS OF FREEDOM in the last sixteenth. WINDS OF FREEDOM bumped with inner rival in the beginning, showed the way with FAR WESTERN alongside, edged clear from that rival on the turn, challenged by WESTERN FREEDOM midstretch and was outfinished in the late stages. FAR WESTERN pressed the pace from outside to the turn, lost contact with the leader but remained close in the two path, finished willingly down the lane but could not find the needed late kick. PANUCO followed in range early, lost ground in the three path on the turn, then came back on with a mild rally to close the gap late. RUN ABBODY RUN got pinballed leaving the gate, raced outside a rival at the back of the pack, lost ground around the bend and weakened in the lane. UNBREAKABLE TRUST traveled on the inside at the rear, dropped back around the bend and had little left for the stretch run.

BRIGANTE set the pace under pressure from HONEY'S CHOICE to the outside, maintained a short lead through the far turn, dueled into deep stretch and edged clear from the runner-up. HONEY'S CHOICE prompted the pace from outside, dueled into the final furlong, lost the crop past the sixteenth pole but had already started to yield to the winner and held second. KEAGMAN (IRE) stalked the top pair from the rail, steered out with a quarter mile remaining, spun three wide into the lane and finished willingly to earn third. AMERICAN KING tracked in the two path around the first turn, was ridden along through the far turn while eventually finding the rail, also finished willingly through the stretch and got outfinished for third. GREEN SCREEN settled in the two path, moved out three deep in the middle stages, gained three then four wide on the far turn but flattened down the stretch. RAGING INFERNO was rank into the first turn along the rail, saved ground through the far turn, had to wait when boxed in briefly at the three-sixteenths pole and could not rally once finding a clear path. WHYNOTANOTHERONE stumbled leaving the gate, trailed and had to alter out from behind RAGING INFERNO into the first turn, asked two wide around the second bend and could not make an impact. BORN TO ROCK stalked three wide around the clubhouse turn, came under a ride still in the three path on the second bend and weakened.

TEMPUS VOLAT dueled for the lead from inside into the first turn, ceded command around the bend, stalked up the backstretch along the rail, drafted behind the leader on the far turn, tipped out at the top of the lane, drew alongside FRIENDLY CONFINES at the eighth pole and proved best in the last sixteenth. FRIENDLY CONFINES dueled from outside into the first turn then cleared inner rival and moved to the rail, set all the pace unchallenged to the stretch, confronted by TEMPUS VOLAT at the eighth pole, was outfinished in deep stretch and managed to hold on for second. LYLE THE CROCODILE (IRE) tucked inside at the back, trailed to the far turn, waited in the two path at the quarter pole, angled out into the lane, closed well in the final furlong and just missed the place honors. HIDING IN HONDURAS raced keenly early between rivals, got pinballed early on the clubhouse turn, settled off the pace on the inside, followed in range on the second turn, kept on down the lane but needed to find more. BODI ZAFa tracked inside rivals into the first turn, bumped twice and steadied around the bend, raced near the back in the middle stages, asked two, three, then four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. MYSTIC MOSES broke in and bumped, duelled from inside up the backstretch and around the turn holding a slight advantage, yielded to ANOTHER BULLEIT in upper stretch but stayed on well for a clear second. JOKER WENT WILD bumped leaving the gate, chased off the rail to the turn, navigated the bend three wide and lacked the necessary bid. EYE OF THE SMILEY tracked the top pair from inside, saved ground through the turn, moved out at the top of the lane and weakened in the lane. ROCKY COLAVITO got floated in and paused early, ridden along two then three wide on the turn and failed to rally in the stretch. KIKI RIDE saved ground from off the pace and failed to menace. AMBAYA hopped at the start and lost a couple lengths, settled on the inside, moved into range leaving the backstretch, bid between runners at the eighth pole, dueled outside RIBBONS in deep stretch and got denied. THE MIZEN QUEEN (IRE) stalked the pacesetter from the rail, followed behind leader on the far turn, tipped two wide late on the bend, bid three deep with a furlong remaining but flattened out in the final sixteenth. LILA brushed leaving the gate, raced along the inside towards the rear, steadied past the three-eighths pole, lacked room and bumped with outer rival at the quarter pole, showed late effort down the lane and rounded out the superfecta. RESOLVE unhurried in the early going and steered to the two path, rounded the far turn three then four wide, tipped out at the top of the lane and improved position. TAKE ANOTHER CARD sat off the pace in the two path, bumped with LILA at the quarter pole, paused while awaiting room in upper stretch and failed to threaten after. CAT THE CONFIDANTE (IRE) broke out and brushed, raced near the back along the inside, went two wide into the far turn, spun five wide into the lane and lacked a rally. HEY LIL LADY traveled three deep off the pace, was asked three then four wide on the far turn and weakened in the drive. TIGERISH rated in the two path stalking the pacesetter, roused on the far turn, chased three wide into the lane and faded in the lane. POLYTHENE PAM tracked two wide in the early going, chased within striking distance between foes at the quarter pole and tired in the stretch run.
