Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

PRINCESA MOCHE (PER) showed early quickness then ceded command to CERTITUDE (FR), was closest in pursuit in the early going on the inside well out of range, closed in around the far turn, tipped out at the top of the lane, drew alongside CERTITUDE (FR) with a furlong remaining and drew clear under hand urging. HANNAH BUCKLE (IRE) reserved in the two path, coaxed along between rivals on the backstretch, remained two wide on the far turn, rallied under right handed encouragement and gained second. CERTITUDE (FR) sprinted clear and opened up a bid lead, held a diminished lead still clear around the far turn, moved out in upper stretch, asked right handed when challenged by the winner at the eighth pole, lost command midstretch and managed to save third. BALTIC FIRE laid off the pace on the inside, hugged the rail to the stretch, summoned a mild rally and missed third. WORD PLAY (GB) tracked in the two path well out of range early, drew closer under coaxing on the far turn, steered out in the lane, chased within striking distance in the furlong grounds but finished evenly late. MOMENT'S PLEASURE raced between rivals at the back into the clubhouse turn, trailed outside a runner on the backstretch, angled four wide around the far turn, kept trying down the lane but needed to find more. SAKURA BLOSSOM steadied a bit early behind a rival into the first turn, traveled inside a runner at the back in the middle stages, asked right handed still next to the fence turning for home and failed to rally.

LAUDATORY unhurried four deep in the early going, remained wide up the backstretch, chased four then three deep on the far turn and never responded to urging. JANE AUSTEN sat off the pace three deep, got crowded between rivals early on the far turn, chased two wide into the lane and had little left for the drive.
