STRONGERTHANBEFORE pressed from outside to the turn, took over at the quarter pole, led two wide into the lane, yielded to BERLIN WALL in upper stretch, flattened late and saved third. CULLEN J raced up close three deep, driven four wide into the lane and weakened. OUR BUCKY CHARM was forwardly placed four deep in the early going, chased five wide leaving the bend and also weakened. TIGER IN MY TANK showed the way under pressure up the backstretch, dueled and lost command on the turn, then faded in the drive. MR. DISRESPECTFUL threw his head, then hopped and unseated his rider at the start, ran around the outer part of the track before being caught by the outrider near the eighth pole and walked off. THERE WAS AN INQUIRY INVOLVING THE START OF MR. DISRESPECTFUL. FOLLOWING A REVIEW, THE STEWARDS UNANIMOUSLY RULED THAT HE CAUSED HIS OWN PROBLEMS AT THE START AND IS CONSIDERED A STARTER.

REVERA raced outside the top pair up the backstretch, fought three deep around the bend, dueled with HIMIKA down the lane and dug in to best that rival in the last sixteenth. HIMIKA flanked the leader from outside early, applied more pressure at the half-mile pole, vied between rivals and took over late on the turn, lost command dueling with REVERA midstretch and stayed on for a game second. COSMIC HEAT broke a step slow and outward, lagged behind early, went two wide into the turn then found the rail, summoned a mild rally in the lane and ran on for third. HEAVEN'S BOLT tracked the top trio from off the rail, took the turn four wide and weakened in the lane. STUFFY MIST stalked the leaders from inside, roused two in the two path coming into the stretch, moved out further in the lane but flattened out. BOURBON AND GINGER established the front quickly, showed the way under pressure past the half-mile pole, fought with outer pair around the bend, lost command late on the bend, failed to kick on with the top pair entering the lane and weakened.

LOW EXPECTATIONS settled in the two path, coaxed along on the backstretch, gained three then four wide on the far turn, rallied three deep into the final sixteenth and outbobbed JOINT VENTURE at the wire. JOINT VENTURE rated on the inside in the opening stages, drafted behind the leader while saving ground on the far turn, tipped out at the top of the lane, bid between rivals late and lost the bob to the winner. FEEL THE MAGIC chased five, four, then three wide on the clubhouse turn, bid four deepu on the second bend, led three wide into the lane, drew clear in upper stretch but got run down by the top pair in deep stretch. MISCHIEFS CAUSEWAY dueled from outside, vied between up the backstretch, yielded to leaders at the five-sixteenths pole, chased in the two path turning for home, flattened in the lane but was able to earn a minor award. GREAT KING (FR) dueled from inside around the first turn, fought inside a pair of rivals up the backstretch, inched ahead on the far turn before behind headed by FEEL THE MAGIC past the quarter pole, lost command entering the lane, yielded to the new leader in upper stretch and weakened in the furlong grounds. VERITAS AEQUITAS trailed four then three wide on the

CODY BOY got put in tight and steadied into the first turn, pulled along the inside and took up around the bend, laid off the pace up the backstretch, angled out on the far turn, entered the lane in the five path and failed to menace. BIG JUANITO chased three then four wide around the first turn, tugged forward and challenged for command three deep on the backstretch, failed to kick on with the leaders approaching the quarter pole and tired down the lane. IMPOSSIBLE TASK raced near the back five wide into the first turn, drifted out a bit more around the bend, fought the rider at the midway point, eased leaving the backstretch and far turn, pulled up with the outrider in upper stretch and walked off.
