HAWKER vied three deep up the backstretch, dueled outside HARD TO FIGURE on the turn, put that rival away at the top of the stretch, drew off under urging and was in hand near the wire. HARD TO FIGURE vied between rivals to the turn, dueled inside HAWKER around the bend, was no match for that rival in upper stretch and managed to hold second. CAPTAIN SPARROW raced up close four deep early on, angled to the two path then came three wide into the lane, kept trying down the stretch but failed to get by HARD TO FIGURE for second. STOLEN TREASURE trailed out wide, angled into the two path entering the turn, steered back out and came five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. MYSTIC FLYER stalked five deep in the opening stages, angled into the three path midway around the bend, tipped back out and chase four wide into the lane and weakened. TEQUILA TALKIN vied inside a pair of rivals to the turn, got crowded a bit at the three-eighths pole, dropped back after and faded in the lane.
