MIYAKO sprinted clear and opened up a comfortable lead early, set all the pace from inside ot the stretch, given her cue with a furlong remaining and held safely under right handed encouragement. CAT THE CONFIDANTE (IRE) settled along the rail, followed from mid-pack to the far turn, made progress from the fence around the bend, cut the corner into the lane, moved out and took aim in upper stretch, could not reach the winner but stayed on to secure second. REHEARSAL (IRE) raced outside a rival well off the pace, remained two wide around the far turn, steered out at the top of the lane, closed well and almost got up for second. TIME TO SHINE broke in and bumped, reserved between rivals then angled to the inside, saved ground around the far turn as well, showed a mild response when called upon and earned a minor award. MAGALE tracked the pacesetter from inside around the clubhouse turn, moved to the two path on the backstretch, chased between rivals in upper stretch and could not rally. GARDEN PARTY pulled early and steered to the two path,

SAKURA FLAVOR (IRE) traveled near the back on the inside, hugged the rail through the far turn, moved out in upper stretch then came back to the inside and never threatened. ALERAMO (IRE) leaned back and took a bump from outside leaving the gate, trailed in the two path, asked around the far turn, angled out in the lane and failed to menace. CHURCH LADY (IRE) tracked outside a rival or in the two path, three deep on the backstretch, spun four wide into the lane and weakened. INFINITY DREAM was closest in pursuit of MIYAKO from inside around both turns, raced a bit off the rail into the lane and weakened.
