CORONA DE ORO broke a step slow, tracked along the inside, checked while pausing behind a foe at the five sixteenths pole, managed to slip through at the quarter pole, rallied up to the rail to bid passing the furlong grounds and edged ahead. VOLENDAM raced close up three wide and between horses, forged place while chasing the clear leader two wide coming to the two path, ran on to bid inside of the leader along with an inner rival at the furlong grounds, vied before leaning in subtly and shying in the final sixteenth then settled for place. SUPER HAPPY vied outside of rivals early on, drew clear in the four path with three furlongs to go but got collared by an inner pair passing the furlong grounds and yielded. REBEL INSTINCT stalked four wide and between horses around the turn, chased the top trio from the five path into the lane then yielded yet saved fourth at the wire. KOKOMO JOE stumbled at the start, lagged behind along the inside then moved up along the rail to miss fourth. RING CURL vied for the lead along the inside, chased an outer clearing counterpart leaving the three furlong marker then faded between rivals at the quarter pole. VINTAGE COWBOY vied two wide and between horses, chased into the turn then steadily faded between rivals thereafter. QUARRY chased six wide then tired. JOIN tracked five wide then weakened turning for home. THE RIDER OF VOLENDAM CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST CORONA DE ORO ALLEGING INTERFERENCE IN DEEP STRETCH, BUT THE OBJECTION WAS DISALLOWED BY THE STEWARDS.
