QUICK TO CHARM tracked from the two path, tipped four wide at the quarter pole, ranged up to bid outside of the leader in upper stretch, dueled with that one thereafter and prevailed. SHIPS INN prompted two wide and between horses, vied into the turn, led with five sixteenths to go, dug in while getting collared by an outer challenger in upper stretch, battled gamely through the final furlong but was bested. SHOT AT PERFECTION pursued from the two to three path into the turn, chased while being floated five wide at the quarter pole then stayed on mildly. POINT IN TIME raced off of the pace in the four path, shifted out to the six path in upper stretch and improved position. MANCUSO pressed three wide, bid at the three furlong pole but faded between horses entering the lane. GORRONE RANCH led inside of a pair of prompters into the turn, vied with them passing the three furlong pole, but yielded with five sixteenths to go then faded. STELLA DANIELLA broke a step slow, lagged behind in the two path, moved out to the seven path leaving upper stretch and got outrun.
