BALACLAVA raced off of the pace in the three path and between horses early on, chased under urging outside of rivals around the turn, moved out to the five path entering the lane, rallied to bid outside of the leader at the sixteenth pole and edged past. ALTA AVENUE set a clear pace in the two path early on, met a pair of outer challenges at the five sixteenths pole, vied with those bidders turning for home, clung to an advantage before shaking free of those foes as a wider rival threatened at the sixteenth pole, but was bested late. TIZIANNA stalked from the three path, bid outside of the leader and along with an outer rival at the five sixteenths pole, vied between horses turning for home but was repelled at the sixteenth marker then held show. JABOSS bumped the gate while off slow, steadily advanced in the four path down the backstretch, bid outside of the top pair at the five sixteenths pole, vied turning for home but faded between horses leaving midstretch. BARTENDER raced off of the pace along the inside, tipped two wide and between horses nearing the turn, chased into the lane and flattened out. COLD CASE trailed in the two path, then the four to five path turning for home and failed to factor. GLAZIN' FURY stalked along the inside then faded around the turn.
