CANT STOP MUNNINGS settled off the pace stalking from inside a foe, shifted in leaving the backstretch racing two to three deep outside a rival into the turn, moved out about the five-sixteenths advancing between runners, came to the top of the stretch four deep with aim, struck the lead a sixteenth out and prevailed. GOOD MOJO vied inside from the outset, was just off the rail on the turn, kicked clear of rivals turning into upper stretch, headed about the sixteenth pole and fought on gamely but was second best. ANOTHER MONARCH pursued from outside racing five to six deep on the turn, drifted in a bit in upper stretch, kept on without threatening the top pair but was best of the rest. IMPAVIDO angled in early, advanced near the rail early on the turn, ran on. BIG TECH exchanged a light brush after the start, chased from outside then between foes four to five wide, failed to rally. WHITE WHALE came out a bit at the start lightly brushing a foe soon after, was prominent between runners early then stalked the leading pair, advanced on the leader mildly near the five-sixteenths racing three to four deep, could not sustain the effort. DISPERSION vied between runners then dueled outside the runner-up pressing that one into the turn, was done at the five-sixteenths and dropped back.

JACK'S BACK soon took a narrow lead from outside forcing the issue three to four wide into and on the turn, lugged out a bit in upper stretch now in command, held sway under steady handling. LOOKISM steadied past the nine-sixteenths racing in behind the leading group, waited briefly near the five-sixteenths racing two to three wide on the turn, was asked soon after but still in search of room, found it in upper- to mid-stretch, loomed a threat but could make no headway late. MR. FETE chased the leading trio from outside a foe, went three to five wide on the turn, kept on evenly and saved show honors. FORTUNISTIC chased from off the inside and well back of the leaders, raced in the three to four path on the turn, came wider into upper stretch then shifted in a bit in mid-stretch, kept on late but missed third. JOE JOE DUDE got away well, vied between runners, weakened. CHARLATAN WEST broke awkwardly and a step slowly, was encouraged along up the backstretch lacking speed, passed a couple tired ones. HEART OF A HERO was urged forward inside, vied for the lead, faltered and faded. THUNDER TOWN lacked speed, raced inside and was never near enough to threaten.

SOUTHERN KISS was in a bit tight after the start, settled near the inside, advanced two wide on the turn reaching striking distance when tipping out at the top of the stretch, bumped the outside foe in the process, struck the lead past the furlong marker, led late but was outfinished. DONIE MARONIE chased from outside a foe into the turn, moved out from three to five wide on that bend, was bumped in upper stretch, kept on to gain show honors. CALLIE'S DANCE was forwardly-placed from the start, tucked in behind the leader heading into the first turn tracking, moved out advancing three wide coming past the quarter pole, bid at the top of the stretch, was overtaken past the furlong marker and had no extra. SHE KNOWS BETTER hesitated at the start, trailed early, swung seven wide into upper stretch, moved in a bit and ran on to improve position. KIHAI KIANA was outside off the pace going three to four wide on the turn, swung nine deep turning for home and ran on evenly. OPALITE DUST tracked up close inside saving ground through the turn, came out in mid-stretch to pass a tiring rival, failed to rally. SO SANDY was sent forward after the break, contested the early pace from the rail position, traded the lead with CLASSIC CAR WASH with neither rival in any particular hurry early on, then set down with that rival leaving the three-furlong pole, staged a stirring duel through the stretch while pulling clear of the rest, got a head in front in the final yards and held sway to the finish. CLASSIC CAR WASH broke on top, then dueled to the outside of SO SANDY, neither foe seemingly wanting to go all-in early on, quickened away from the rest from mid-turn, dueled gamely, but was headed in the final yards. SPECIAL SESSION was allowed to settle mid-pack, raced between horses in the second flight to the far turn, was under a drive but not responding on the far turn, was kept to task and found more in the final furlong to move up and take the third prize. SIR HANSEN tracked the pace closely early, saved ground just off the leaders through the first half, remained within striking distance while patiently handled on the turn, rallied when set down in upper stretch, closed ground willingly, and dead-heated for the win in a blanket finish. GOOD TO BE KING showed good early speed to lead into the first turn, ceded the front down the backstretch to stalk BAYTOWN DA VINCI, engaged that rival nearing the three-furlong pole, regained the lead entering the stretch, was immediately bumped by the surging FERROUS in upper stretch, fought back gamely, and dead-heated for the win at the wire. FERROUS settled two or three wide early, made an eye-catching move through the far turn to bid for the lead approaching the stretch, ducked in and made contact with the inside rival in upper stretch, kept on well but was outfinished by the top pair in a tight finish.

BANKSY'S was allowed to settle in mid-pack early, began a sustained forward move at the seven-sixteenths marker, went three wide through the far turn, and continued on in workmanlike fashion to get up in the final yards. TEND TO YOU broke cleanly, tracked the runaway early leader from second position, chased and collared that rival with a sixteenth to go alongside a surging BANKSY'S, but yielded to that latter foe in the final strides. LIMELIGHT was sent

aggressively to the lead, went clear of the rest, and was left alone to dictate moderate early fractions, maintained a clear margin through the far turn, continued to lead while under strong handling past the furlong marker, but gave way in that final furlong. DIAMOND EYED JACK settled unhurried in the back half of the field, circled four to five wide on the far turn, closed steadily in the stretch, but ran out of time. LET'S BE FRANK stumbled coming out of the gate, saved ground to the stretch, and was gaining ground in the late stages. MASSACHUSETTS tracked off the pace toward the inside, came under a ride near the three-furlong pole, maintained position while being hard ridden but did not improve. TERRE HAUTE got good forward position three-wide on the first turn, settled in the tracking group down the backstretch, came under a ride early on the far turn, but did not respond, and faded through the field in the stretch. EL TIO settled with the trailing group and was never involved. RAVENOUS lagged at the rear of the field and did not offer a late bid. SLIDE AWAY ducked in after the break and made contact with the temporary inner rail, then trailed the field and failed to rally.
