BATTLEFIELD HERO stalked in the four path, ranged up to bid outside of the top pair at the five sixteenths pole, dueled with only an inner rival into the lane and edged an advantage while hanging on his left lead in the final sixteenth. BRAVO TANGO pressed two wide, bid along with an outer rival at the five sixteenths pole, dueled with that one into the lane, fought on gamely in the final furlong but was bested then held place. ET AL raced forwardly along the inside, chased while moving out to the four path in upper stretch, stayed on between rivals leaving the furlong grounds, battled with an outer rival for show late and prevailed. NO MO SUN tracked from the three path and between horses, chased while being floated to the five pat in upper stretch, stayed on to duel for show with an inner foe late but missed at the wire. KING CRUSHER set a pressured pace along the inside, vied with an outer pair of bidders at the five sixteenths pole, got headed shortly after, proved no match for them entering upper stretch, faded and lost show in the final sixteenth. KILBARRY was slow into stride, trailed in the four path, fanned to the six path in upper stretch and failed to menace. MEGA BLUE bumped with an outer rival at the start, then saved ground off of the pace but to no avail. PATRIOTS POINT was reluctant to load, bumped with an inner foe at the start, raced off of the pace in the three to four path, moved to the five path in upper stretch and made little impact.
