YO FANCY raced back early on, was in the six path into the lane, rallied down the lane, drove past the leader and cleared the field in the final stages. KAYKAY set the pace early on, raced in the two path into the lane, opened up a bit down the lane but yielded late in the drive. GERBER DAISY raced back early on, was in the four path into the lane, made a bid down the lane and rallied for show in the late stages. BY LA RINA tracked the pace early on from between horses, raced in the three path into the lane, made a bid in the stretch but weakened late in the drive and lost show. THAT'S A BENJAMIN chased the pace early on, raced in the two path into the lane and flattened out late in the stretch run. LEXI V. was unhurried early on along the inside, fanned into the five path entering the lane and moved up late in the stretch drive. TWAS THE LAW trailed the field early, raced in the four path into the lane and improved position down the lane. ZENGRAYA tracked the pace early on three wide, raced in the five path into the lane and faded late in the stretch run. R KENDL was done early on. COSMOPOLITAN LADY was never a factor. WINNING MATTERS broke a tad slow at the start then was rushed up along the inside, raced off the rail into the lane and was tired down the lane. ANNA OF AUSTRIA hopped at the start, raced four wide early on, was widest into the lane and folded up in the stretch.
