WRONG SHOES tracked along the inside, inched closer in hand turning for home, loomed a danger aiming outside of the leader at the quarter pole, bid and took charge entering the lane then kicked away under mild urging. LOCKDOWNYOURTOWN stalked from the four path, chased around the turn, got outkicked by an inner bidder at the quarter pole, claimed place leaving upper stretch and proved second best. BELLE OFTHE DANCE brushed with an outer rival while off a step slow, raced off of the pace in the two path, spun into the lane in the four path then moved up. NIGHTMARE FUEL set the pace in thetwo path, got headed by an outer bidder entering the lane and gave way. LADY PIPPA came in at the start, pressed the leader from the three path, got outkicked between rivals at the quarter pole and faded. COLD CASE brushed with an inner rival at the start, trailed in the four path, tucked to the inside nearing the lane and failed to factor. DUCAT bumped the gate and was off a step slow, came under a drive while off of the pace tucking to the three path into the turn, then weakened.
