## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

THE GRUMPY RABBIT bumped with an outer rival at the start, prompted outside of the leader and from the three path, bid at the three furlong pole, led leaving the five sixteenths marker, cleared entering the lane and drew off under a drive. MORNING MENACE showed the way as the eventual winner applied stern pressure, got headed by that one at the five sixteenths pole, proved no match entering the lane and was second best. GINGER ALE bumped with an inner foe at the start, stalked outside of the top pair and from the four path, chased them while failing to keep pace in the three path around the far turn, lacked a bid yet managed show. HOWYOUDOSOMETHING broke a step slow, raced off of the pace in the three path then advanced turning for home. EVANGALINA tracked while tucking down to the two path into the backstretch, but faded around the far turn. ALAS was bumped by an inner rival at the start, raced off of the pace in the two path, moved out to the four path around the far turn and failed to factor. AMES leaned outwardly and bumped a rival leaving the gate, tracked along the inside while tugging into the backstretch, but faded rounding the far turn and was eased through the lane.
