CAN'TDEALWITHIT was off a step slow then saved ground while being allowed to settle, lacked room nearing the quarter pole, slipped through entering the stretch, took the lead nearing the eighth pole and quickly drew clear. CHOKECHERY SHARI was reserved off the pace, came three-wide into the stretch, angled in nearing the eighth pole and finished in a mild rally. BUMPING RIVER saved ground setting the pace, drifted out slightly entering the stretch and held on fairly well for the show. SAVITA saved ground while being unhurried, angled out to be three-wide nearing the eighth pole and rallied late. DANDY DAY settled in the middle of the field, came six-wide into the stretch and went evenly late. RABBLE prompted BUMPING RIVER from along the outside and weakened during the drive. HAKUHIA was prominently placed early racing three-wide and tired. POCKET KNIFE broke in and steadied at the start then raced in the back of the field while two-wide and failed to menace.
