VULIN chased the pace while saving ground, slipped through entering the stretch and finished strongly to up in the final strides. NEPHELE was three-wide racing in the middle of the field, came five-wide into the stretch and finished fast. BANGIE GO vied with GREATFUL ATTITUDE for the lead, came three-wide into the stretch and held on gamely during the drive. GREATFUL ATTITUDE vied for the lead with BANGIE GO from along the inside, came two-wide into the stretch and weakened slightly late. VIEWERS DISCRETION was forwardly placed racing three-wide but lacked a rally. SUNGLASSES (GB) was unhurried, rallied six-wide into the stretch but failed to threaten. WHITE PEONY was allowed to settle racing four-wide and failed to be a factor.
