STRATOJET vied with SILICON NATIVE for the lead from along the inside, shook that one off nearing the stretch and quickly drew clear. ONE PHIL was prominent racing four-wide, moved up to offer a bid at the quarter pole but was unable to reach the winner while proving to be second best. THREE P'S saved ground while being allowed to settle, slipped through during the drive and finished in a mild rally. MELVINS LUTE saved ground racing in the back of the field and gained his best stride too late. THE BRONX BULL was unhurried while racing three-wide, came four-wide into the stretch and improved his position. COLONEL BROCK was forwardly placed racing three-wide to the stretch and weakened. SILICON NATIVE vied for the lead to near the stretch from along the outside and tired. SIR BARK KNIGHT raced in the middle of the field while two-wide, came three-wide into the stretch and gave way during the drive.
